Airtel to Los Angeles Re: Vincent Alo

NOTE: The Los Angeles Office has under investigation a case involving Vincent Alo, Anthony Salerno, Elliot Paul Price, Jerome Zarowitz, and Ruby Lazarus. This group met during October, 1965, at the time of the 1965 world series. The group met at a Palm Springs, California, residence to discuss approximately \$200,000.00 worth of gambling shortages caused by Ruby Lazarus. Numerous telephone calls were made from the quarters being occupied by the above group to gamblers all over the country. A previous investigation had determined that Alo and Salerno belong to La Cosa Nostra "Family" headed by Jerry Catena of Newark, New Jersey. Elliot Paul Price is a nationally prominent "lay-off" bookmaker. This case is presently under investigation by Federal grand jury, Los Angeles, California. Ruby Lazarus declined to answer questions after being granted immunity and is incarcerated in contempt of court.

Los Angeles reports that AUSA Stephen D. Miller who questioned before a grand jury has advised attorney that he. Miller, is making masse recommendations as to prosecution of concerning her testimony and is resigning from USA's office 5/1/67. Miller is reportedly making arrangements to begin "dating" Lockwood after he resignes. Lockwood's attorney, Adrian Marshall, is also interested in "dating" her. In view of fact that all information is coming from LA 4476-C-TE, who himself has been living with and supporting Lockwood and who is the law partner of Adrian Marshall, the Los Angeles Office is being querried as to whether this information can be disseminated to the Department without endangering source. If it can be Los Angeles is being instructed to discreetly verify whether Miller actually is going to resign 5/1/67, and to supply letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination.
