On 3/29/67, LA 4476-C-TE advised SA GEORGE E. BLAND that the United States Marshal served _______ on 3/28/67, for her appearance before the Federal Grand Jury (FGJ) on 4/6/67. Her comment was there was nothing to worry about because she is going to tell the truth concerning JFK-Law 10(a)2

On 3/30/67, the source learned that SIDNEY GATHRID threatened to commit suicide in Las Vegas by jumping out the window. He had been depressed about money because he is now making less working at Caesar's Palace than he previously did at his old job. ZAROWITZ offered him money but he declined. GATHRID does not like Las Vegas or JAY SARNO.

On 4/5/67, the source advised that Lockwood was taken by attorney, ADRIAN MARSHALL to meet with AUSA DAVID M. MILLER at 8:00 AM on 4/5/67. She had previously, possibly the day before, met with MARSHALL and BRYANT BURTON, at which time they both told her to tell the truth about who she was now living with, which is the source, some of the presents she had received from ZAROWITZ, and that she had lived with him.

On 4/13/67, the source advised that according to LOCKWOOD, ZAROWITZ is now "putting the arm" on HOWARD KOCH, President of Paramount Pictures, for a one year contract for \$250.00 per week for LOCKWOOD.

On 5/3/67, LV 117-C-TE advised that several of the officials at Caesar's Palace, principally ZAROWITZ and PRICE, expressed concern over the incarceration of RUBY LAZARUS and were overheard to say that "SID" had visited him on Monday, 5/1/67, to "take care of him".

LA 4476-C-TE advised on 5/4/67 that on 5/1/67, he introduced LOCKWOOD to Attorney General RAMSEY CLARK at a party held at the Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, California, following a Law Day conference.

LOCKWOOD told source later in the evening that the meeting in Palm Springs concerned financial difficulties of Caesar's Palace as only ZAROWITZ had put money into the operation, but JAY SARNO and NATE JACOBSON, owners of record, had not made

any financial investment. ZAROWITZ contacted ALO and SALERNO who came to Palm Springs and according to LOCKWOOD put in "millions of dollars." The exact amount invested by ALO and SALERNO, or the amount of points received by them was not known to LOCKWOOD. According to LOCKWOOD, gambling at Palm Springs was only incidental.

On 5/19/67, the above source advised that LOCKWOOD told source that last week she ran out of money and she called ZAROWITZ, who flew into Los Angeles and gave her \$2,000.00. Source believed this to be true because she has done a lot of work on her house and has purchased stock.

On 4/13/67, MM 509-C-TE advised SA ROBERT F. FETZNER that LOUIS ROTONDO has been ordered to pay the wife of RUBY LAZARUS (BEVERLY LAZARUS) a sum of \$150.00 a month on behalf of ANTHONY "FAT TONY" SALERNO and the "boys" as long as RUBY is confined to jail. A further stipulation according to source is that BEVERLY LAZARUS does not talk to any law enforcement agencies.

LOUIS COTONDO, FBI number 2 639 857 is a known lieutenant and "front man" for SALERNO. He has long been active in the rackets in both the New York City and Miami, Florida areas.

LA 4935-PC advised he learned from a casino employee of Caesar's Palace on June 13, 1967, that ZAROWITZ believed he would be subpoened, granted immunity and because he could not talk he would go to jail.
