CG SIX FOUR FOUR THREE DASH C WAS RECONTACTED IN REGARD TO STOCK ALLEGEDLY OWNED BY ALEX IN THE HILTON HOTEL CHAIN. INFORMANT ADVISED THAT IN REGARD TO THIS INFORMATION HE HAD LEARNED OF THE POSSIBLE OWNERSHIP OF STOCK IN THE HILTON HOTEL CHAIN BY ALEX, TONY ACCARDO AND OTHER HOODLUMS MANY YEARS AGO THROUGH A BROKER WHO HE BELIEVES WAS ONE IRWIN NICHOLSON WHO THEN WORKED FOR A BROKERAGE FIRM KNOWN AS SUTRO BROTHERS, A NOW DEFUNCT CO. INFORMANT ADVISED THAT HE WAS IN THE BROKERAGE OFFICE OF THIS CO. TALKING TO NICHOLSON WHEN SOME QUOTE OUTFIT UNQUOTE INDIVIDUALS CAME IN AND BOUGHT LARGE QUANTITIES OF STOCK. AT THAT TIME THE HILTON STOCK WAS JUST COMING ON THE MARKET AS HE RECALLED AND WAS VALUED AT ABOUT SIX DOLLARS A SHARE. INFORMANT ADVISED THAT HE DID NOT KNOW THE PRESENT WHEREABOUTS OF NICHOLSON
