On 3/22/62, DL-95-C stated that DON FULTON, part owner of the Redman Club, 3109 West Davis, Dallas, told CI that ELMER CLUCK also part owner of the club had advised FULTON that during the Fall of 1961 CLUCK's girl friend had approached CLUCK to "set up" her husband for \$20,000. This husband, GORDON MINSCHEW, a Hawkins, Texas Postal employee, had been found murdered near Hawkins, Texas. CI also stated that CLUCK was again arrested by an unknown law enforcement agency on 3/21/62 for requestioning concerning this murder. The above information was orally furnished to LT. JACK REVILL, Dallas PD on 3/22/62.

On 3/22/62, officers of the Dallas PD contacted the Dallas Office for information concerning TORTORIELLO as they had received information from an informant that he was possibly involved in recent jewel thefts in Dallas. Based on the background information furnished by the FBI Dallas, TORTORIELLO was arrested at his residence on 3/22/62 by the PD and his apartment was searched. Officers noted that there was not one scrap of paper in the apartment with a name or phone number on it and that this appeared to be extremely odd to them. TORTORIELLO was extremely polite but when told that he was going to be fingerprinted and photographed he became quite upset. He admitted that he was a gambler, he had over \$1,000

On 3/21/62, LT. JACK REVILL advised that one EARL ABRAHAM FOREMAN had taken over as new owner of the Roadrunner Tavern, 4503 Columbia. This is a known hangout for police characters, pimps and prostitutes. PD informants had ascertained that prostitutes were obtaining dates at this tavern.

Re: RICHARD LEE BLANKENSHIP, aka. FUGITIVE, ITSP (DL 87-9733)

On 3/26/62, SA ALFRED D. NEELEY received information that PEGGY ANN FRYE, subject's girl friend, had been arrested during an attempted armed robbery at Artesia, N.M. on 3/25/62 but that her associate, unidentified, had escaped. Later on the morning of 3/26/62, subject, who is brother of ELVIS RAY BLANKENSHIP (DL 92-222), ROBERT LEE HERROD and HERROD's wife (possibly identical with Ft. Worth prostitute BETTY JOYCE PHIFER) were apprehended by local authorities at 6 AM in a farm house they had rented near Gainesville, Texas. Bureau Agents are interviewing these people 3/26/62.
