SANTO TRAFFICANTE, JR., AKA. AR. DAILY TELETYPE. MIAMI HAS ADVISED BOB GARDNER, BELLHOP, DE LIDO HOTEL, LINCOLN ROAD AND COLLINS AVENUE, MIAMI BEACH, ADVISED NOVEMBER FOURTEEN, SIXTY ONE THAT SUCH HOTEL SENT OUT CIRCULARS TO ALL PREVIOUS GUESTS. HOWEVER, CHECK OF REGISTRATION CARDS FOR NINETEEN SIXTY DASH SIXTY ONE FAILED TO REVEAL CARD FOR SUBJECT-S NAME. MIAMI ADVISED SYLVIA CORSETRY CEASED TO DO BUSINESS ABOUT ONE YEAR AGO. ATLANTA ADVISED SV TWO SIX THREE DASH C CONTACTED DECEMBER FIFTEEN AND ADVISED HE PREFERRED NOT TO IDENTIFY HIS FRIEND IN ATLANTA. JOE CRENSHAW, EASTERN AIR LINES, INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, TAMPA, AS WELL AS PHIL CICCARELLO AND CHARLES TURRENTINE, NATIONAL AIR LINES, TAMPA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, ADVISED DECEMBER TWENTY SIX SUBJECT PERSONALLY KNOWN TO THEM AND HE HAS NOT USED EASTERN NOR NATIONAL FACILITIES. CICCARELLO ADVISED HE HEARD FROM UNKNOWN SOURCE AT TAMPA DOG TRACK ON NIGHT OF DECEMBER TWENTY THREE LAST THAT SUBJECT WAS HOME FOR CHRISTMAS. HE SUGGESTED FBI, MIAMI CONTACT HIS FATHER, JOE CICCAREELO, EMPLOYED BY PAN AMERICAN AIR LINES AT MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, WHO SEES ALL PERSONS COMING AND GOING ON SOUTH AMERICAN OR FOREIGN COUNTRY FLIGHTS AND PERSONALLY KNOWS
