T-l furnished information that ROSSELLI made a deposit at the California Bank, Highland-Santa Monica Branch, on May 29, 1958.

On June 5, 1958, T-5 advised that JOSEPH I. BREEN, JR. talked with ROSSELLI in Los Angeles on Thursday, May 28, 1958, and that he talked to him on the telephone on Saturday, May 31, 1958. During their discussions on Thursday, BREEN and ROSSELLI discussed what action they would take in regard to the attempts of the Tropicana Hotel to pay Monte Proser Productions, Inc. smaller amounts of money.
