Smoke Shop and his wife, ANN, worked on Water Street. (Water Street was the red light district in Steubenville). CICCARELLI was granted a divorce from his wife, ANN, on 9/25/53. The files contained a notation that the 10/9/58 edition of the Jeffersonian Newspaper, a Steubenville Weekly newspaper, carried an item that CICCARELLI'S name had been legally changed to LOUIS VINCENT CASE. The last known address of CICCARELLI (CASE) was 3062 Southwest 16th Street, Miami, Florida, according to the records of this credit bureau.

On 11/10/58, CI 197-S advised SA ROBERT R.
ROCKWELL that CICCARELLI was in Steubenville during the past month period. During this time he spent time with PHIL MATTUCCI, a local gambler, and he frequented a newly opened gambling establishment known as the Rainbow Gardens located just out of town. The informant thought that it appeared that CICCARELLI was interested in working up some kind of local "deal" in the gambling business in town. He apparently was not successful as he is reported to have returned to Florida. On recontact on 3/16/59 this informant advised that he has not seen CICCARELLI since he left last year and as gambling in town is having a hard time, he probably felt he could do better back in Florida.

Miami will locate and interview CICCARELLI, aka. Case, re his association with subject.

For the info of Miami, PCI Weirton, W.Va., on 2/20/59 advised SA BRONI S. MACYS that his info re subject's presence at the Orange Bowl game in Miami 1/1/59 came from a very reliable source. PCI continued that subject was probably commuting between Cuba and Florida during his absence and said that it was very likely that a Steubenville, Ohio, racketeer named LOU CHICHARELIO (ph) who retired from the rackets in Steubenville sometime ago and is now living in Miami, Fla., could have provided subject with his transportation. PCI explained that CHICHARELIO reportedly retired from the rackets in Steubenville, changed his name, purchased a boat in Miami where he is posing as a "captain" sailing between Cuba and Florida. PCI has promised to obtain additional info along this line if at all possible.

Miami will follow through on investigation requested in Pittsburgh airtel to Bureau, 1/23/59.

Cincinnati is requested to contact logical informants, sources; conduct credit and criminal in an attempt to identify LOU CHICHARELIO. Cincinnati sutel results of investigation re CHICHARELIO to Miami who will then locate and interview re his association with subject.
