On February 16, 1961, Mr. W. G. BEINERT, Internal Revenue representative, American Embassy, London advised

On February 22, 1962, Chief Superintendent O. P. STEFANSSON, Stockholm, Sweden police advised that he had checked alien records and marriage records and there was no record for either subject or Miss MC GUIRE. He pointed out that if they were married in Sweden there would be a record for such a marriage. It is necessary for aliens to submit affidavits indicating they are free to marry before a marriage can be performed in Sweden. (S)(u)
