It is to be noted that Mrs. JANETTE SIMMONS, Longview, Texas, was investigated by the Dallas Division in connection with an appointment as a secretary to Mrs. LYNDON B. JOHNSON, wife of President JOHNSON, during the JOHNSON Administration. She is believed to have been in Washington D.C. for only a short time as she has been contacted by SA BROWN at the Longview Public School Administration Building in connection with other matters.

Mrs. PEARL PRICE, office of the Area Security Supervisors, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, 308 South Akard, was contacted on May 12, 1969, and a request made for a list of toll calls charged to both telephones at subject's residence and place of business.

Mrs. PEARL PRICE was contacted on May 23, 1969, and advised above records had been ordered, but had not been received at this time.

DL T-1 advised on April 4, 1969, that JOE CAMPISI has been making money on horse bets and the source of his tips is DOMINIC (LNU), who works for JAMES VOURAS, owner of Chateaubriand Restaurant. DOMINIC is supposed to know one of the MARCELLO brothers from New Orleans, believed to be VINCENT MARCELLO.

DL T-2 advised on April 28, 1969 that JOE and SAM CAMPISI, who own and operate the Egyptian Lounge and Restaurant, caused him some problems in the past and he would like to see them have some problems. JOE and SAM are both involved in book-making and are both heavy betterers. They play "gin" in the back of the restaurant at least once a week. JOE and SAM CAMPISI are well known gamblers and have been associated as known Italian hoodlums.
