Considerable investigation has been conducted concerning the subject and his activities. This investigation consisted mainly of obtaining long distance telephone tolls for subject's home and business phones. The investigation disclosed that the majority of the telephone calls were to the New Orleans, Louisiana, area, and many were made to the Elmwood Plantation Restaurant which is operated by VINCENT MARCELLO, whose brother is CARLOS MARCELLO, LCN figure in the New Orleans area.

JFK Law 10(a)1

The subject was interviewed on 2/2/72 concerning this and admitted knowing CHAPMAN and having placed bets with him regularly during the football season. He stated that these were his own personal bets. Investigation failed to disclose that the subject was operating as a bookmaker. The [REDACTED] was subpoenaed before the Federal Grand Jury and refused to testify. During this interview, the subject was questioned concerning his ties in the New Orleans area and admitted his friendship with VINCENT MARCELLO and numerous trips he made there to see MARCELLO, claiming these were pleasure trips.

The [REDACTED] has been monitored in a current Title III case captioned. [REDACTED]

JFK Law 10(a)2

The [REDACTED] will be subpoenaed to testify before a Federal Grand Jury in this case.

Information from sources and members of the Dallas Police Department Metro Squad indicates subject's main activity is betting on sporting events and that he is not operating as a bookmaker.
