AUSA B. H. TIMMINS, JR. was requested to issue a Federal Grand Jury subpoena duces tecum for [redacted] pertaining to [redacted] on [redacted]. He was recontacted on 2/17, 3/4 and 3/25/70 concerning this matter and delay in the issuance of the subpoena was entailed in order that Mr. TIMMINS might obtain approval from USA ELDON B. MAHON concerning the procedures.

On 2/17/70, DL 271-C advised SA WILLIAM B. HOLLOMAN that the subject was working part time at Denny's Restaurant on Mockingbird Lane, while JOHNNY STONE, owner of the restaurant, was in the hospital.

On 4/14/70, DL 275-C-TE advised SA WILLIAM B. HOLLOMAN that MILLER was at that time working full time at Denny's Restaurant for JOHNNY STONE and was not doing any bookmaking at the present time.
