Re Paris letter 2/11/65 and Bern airtel 2/4/64.

It was observed that ALEX was listed in the Swiss Police Monitor No. 30 dated 2/12/65, page 421, item 4303, as being the subject of an entry ban for Switzerland.

[redacted] Swiss Federal Department of Justice and Police, informed confidentially on 2/17/65 that this ban by the Swiss Aliens Police was issued at the request of the Zurich Cantonal Police. [redacted] noted that ALEX would be informed of the ban through the Swiss Consulate in Chicago. The reason given for the ban was undesireable foreigner. No further explanation would be given ALEX by the Swiss authorities. He would have the right to appeal, but [redacted] was of the opinion that if he did appeal, there was little chance of the appeal being successful.

As a matter of precaution, the Swiss Police have been requested not to disclose the Bureau as the source of any information concerning ALEX.
