On April 16, 1959, Hav-31 advised that the Hotel Plaza gambling casino had received permission to reopen but that this permission had cost the casino \$50,000. Source advised that because of this high payment, the backers of the casino were now "clean" and were unable to reopen the casino. Source said that efforts are presently being made to attempt to raise additionalbankroll in order to get the casino reopened.
