ANTI-FIDEL CASTRO ACTIVITIES INTERNAL SECURITY - CUBA

×	On July 3, 1965, SJ T-1, a Dominican exile in Puerto Rico with close ties to Cuban exile groups in the Dominican Republic, but with whom insufficient contact has been had to determine his reliability, advised that Maximo Sorondo, a Guban exile who lived in Santo Domingo. Dominican Republic, was the coordinator for the establishment of bases of operation for several Guban anti-Gastro groups in the Dominican Republic. Sorondo's contacts within the	
	Dominican government were the former Commander of the Dominican Air Force, General and a Colonel Sorondo was instrumental in coordinating the setting up of bases for the Segundo Frente Del Escambray (Second National Front of the Escambray) (SNFE), and the Directorio Revolucionario Estudantil (Revolutionary Student Directorate)(DRE) in the Punta Presidente and Catalina Island areas of the Dominican Republic. Sorondo also worked closely with General in planning bases for Comandos L and for the Movimiento Democratico Cristiano (Democratic Christian Movement)(MDC) but that these latter two groups were unable to set up any bases prior to the recent Dominican situation.	
	Source stated that the boats of the SNFE, MDC and DRE, which still remain in the Dominican Republic, are being used as patrol boats by the junta forces of General Antonio Imbert Barrera in the Dominican Republic.

Island and the JURE maintained a boat, the "Venus" at the Dominican naval base near Santo Domingo. Neither r Sorondo had contacts with these latter two groups. Source stated that the JURE contact within the Dominican government was Fomas Cortinas, Chief of Security.

Source advised that Enrique Casado Cuervo was the master of a boat called the "Shark V" and was in the Dominican Republic frequently. Source was of the opinion that Casado was connected in some way with the JUDE or the MER.
