On 8/6/64 SAs J. ROBERT PEARCE and JOSEPH A. VERICA made installation at 1531 S. Broad Street, Phila., first floor, under pretext of telephone men. Installation checked successfully but technical difficulties encountered in routing to CP over leased line. This situation remedied 8/7/64 and source appears to have excellent quality.

For record purposes, outside coverage during installation was afforded by SAs DAVID W. BREEN, ROBERT W. HOLMES and EDWARD D. HEGARTY.

There was no breach of security during trespass and altered telephone "jack" was used in this installation which affords excellent security.
