NY T-1, mentioned in enclosed LHM, is U.S. Navy.

The source of NY T-1 is CYRIL BERTRAM HAMBLETT, Rear Admiral, USNR, (Ret.), who desired that his identity be kept confidential.

HAMBLETT stated that he originally furnished information to Capt. BROWNLEE, DIO-3ND, and at the time there was present with Captain BROWNLEE a Naval officer who is associated with CIA whose name he did not recall.

HAMBLETT also stated that JOSE IGNACIO RASCO had told him that CIA had approached the MDC to offer assistance to the MDC group which is in some Central American country. RASCO
