

In this capacity, he obviously would wield considerable power since the Business Agent determines "who works where". The Business Agent also appoints the steward on the jeb site. He does no work but supposedly checks on the various jobs from time to time. His salary is incrative and is paid from the dues collected from the membership. It has been rusored that MERNE is also a power in Laborers Local #100, AFL-CIO, in East St. Thouse.

ARRAHAM KAWITHAN is a long-time associate of ARTHUR REGNE. He was close to the late BUSTER WORTHAN and his syndicate. Actually, KAWITHAN formerly operated the kitchen at WORTHAN'S Paddock Club which was a gathering place for the hooding element from all over the East St. Louis area. KAWITHAN was also a "bng man" for WORTHAN before he died. Therefore, KAWITHAN enjoys the complete confidence of BERNE. KAWITHAN is now in his sixties and in poor health. He is said to have cancer.

BERNE is also known to be very close to the St. Louis hoodles, LOUIS SHOULDERS.

Very little has been heard lately relative to the ROBINSON brothers, RICHARD and PAUL, in connection with prostitution activity along the Collineville Read area bordering St. Clair and Madison Counties. They are occasionally seen in the Greater East St. Louis area, however, as is BOB CHAPMAN, an associate.

Since ROSS RANDCLPH took over the East St. Louis Police Department, very little is heard relative to police corruption. BANDCLPH, a one-time FSI Agent, has gained the confidence of most East St. Louis residents by cracking down and resbuffling some elements in the department. There is no question but that RANDCLPH has cleased up the department.

The description of the bank robber at the Lebanon Trust and Savings Bank, Lebanon, Illinois, 10/31/69, would seen to closely resemble WILLIAM MC MENTREY (phonetic), Balleville area man who is known to the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax Unit of the Treasury Department.

FRANK KOCOT, owner, Frisco's Tavern, 13th and Hatalie. East St. Louis, is still taking bets on horse racing. He often uses the "Chicago Tribuce" newspaper as a racing form.

OLIVASTRO, Ticket Agent, Eastern Airlines, St. Louis, Municipal Airport on 1/9/70, advised that any flights departing from SL to Roanoke, Va., would only be possible through TWA and Eastern Airlines. These flights would not be direct but would have to go to either Louisville or Wash., D.C., to make appropriate connections. A switch would be necessary from either of the above mentioned airlines to Piedmont Airlines.

MOUREY was sentenced for a period of imprisonment of 10 years, and shall be eligible for parole as the Board of Parole determines under Title 18, Section 4208 (a) (2), count number three. On count number two, defendant was sentenced to 5 years to run concurrently with sentence under count number three. On count one, he was sentenced to 5 years imprisonment. This sentence was to run consecutively with the sentence received under count number three. No fines or costs were assessed.

The above sentence was received in connection with the Post Office burglary committed at Ft. Madison, Iowa, on 11/28/69. Co-defendants JOHN RUSSELL BROWN and RUSSELL EUGENE BRIDDLE wave also found guilty and sentenced

CLINTON ALLEN BRANLET, 13 South Stanley Road, Cottage Hills, Illinois was interviewed concerning his possible involvement in burglaries which occurred in the Alton, Illinois area. Prior to interview, BRANLET was furnished a waiver of rights form which he read, stated he understood, and then signed.

BRAMLET stated that he had worked for McDonnell-Douglas Aircraft for approximately 11 years as a sheet metal worker, and that he had worked on the first shift, that is the day shift during this period. He advised that in the Fall of 1969, that he, in the company of ROBERT LEE COURTOISE and GEORGE ROTHWEILER. both former employees of McDonnell-Douglas, had gone to Tallahassee Florida area on a restaurant venture and had attempted to open a restaurant known as the Fountains Restaurant. BRAMLET stated that he had contributed \$1500 of his money for this restaurant. and that he believed ROTHWEILER had contribued a substantial amount of money from ROTHWEILER's retirement money which he obtained from retirement at McDonnell-Douglas. BRAMLET stated that although he had known COURTOISE for approximately 15 years, that he had only known ROTHWEILER approximately six months prior to going to Florida. BRANLEY stated that inasmuch as the restaurant venture was unsuccessful, that he had returned to the Cottage Hills, Illinois area and has been engaged in the construction of private homes since his return.

BRAMLET stated that he had lived in the Alton, Illinois area for most of his life, and that he was familiar with the area of Bunker Hill, Illinois as well as the Alton, Illinois area, but he denied any knowledge of or participation in the robberies of the First National Bank of Bunker Hill, Illinois, the Bank of Alton, Alton, Illinois, nor of the robbery of the Godfrey State Bank, Godfrey, Illinois.

BRAMLET advised that he had been arrested only once, and that was in the company of ROBERT CCURTOISE, when both had stolen a farm tractor in 1968 in the Bethalto, Illinois area, but served no time for this theft.

BRAMLET advised that he had borrowed \$13,000 to build his house at 13 South Stanley Drive, and that he was attempting to build another house in the Cottage Hills area

COURTOISE advised that he had been working for approximately 5 - 6 years at McDonnell-Douglas Aircraft Company, St. Louis, Missouri, as a fiberglass worker and that in the Fall of 1969, he, in the company of CLINTON BRAILLEY, had gone to the Tallahasse, Florida area with a former supervisor at McDonnell-Douglas Aircraft, GEORGE ROTHWEILER, and that he had performed numerous odd jobs for ROTHWEILER as they were attempting a restaurant venture and the restaurant was known as the Fountains Restaurant in Tallabasse. He advised that at the first part of the year. 1970, that he had returned to the Alton, Illinois area and had been working for the L. A. BAHTON Construction Company and part of the time had worked at a Deep Rock service station, and later was employed for a brief period of time at a Moto Service station in Alton, Illinois.

COURTOISE related that he had lived in the Alton. Illinois area most of his life and was familiar with the areas around Bunker Hill, Illinois, but he specifically denied any knowledge of or participation in the bank robberies of the First National Bank of Bunker Hill, Bunker Hill, Illinois, or the Godfrey State Bank, Godfrey, Illinds.

COUNTOISE related that he had only one serious incident with the law, that being in Bethalto, Illinois in 1968 when he, in the company of CLINTON BRANLEY had been arrested for the theft of a farm tractor, but he did not serve any time for this arrest.

On 2/9/71 JAMES POR, who is incarcerated at the Illinois State Ponitentiary, Menard Branch, Choster, Illinois, was interviewed by the writer. PCR was interviewed because of the fact he has furnished information to Agents of this Bureau in the past after being arrested on local charges.

FOE advised that he is separated from his wife, DIAME He advised that she is presently renaing with her brother. RICHARD BANKER, and a follow from Kontucky. He stated they have been stealing state aid checks and cashing them in Illinois and . . possibly Hissouri.

THE covined that DIAME POR, RIGHERD BARKER, and the fellow from Kontucky, have been Stealing from freight cars in the area of Mitchell, Illinois. He stated the thefts are from the area of Horseshoe Lake neur gate to Granite City Steel sportsman's area. He advised they have been replacing seals on freight cars ofter they have broken the seals and checked the freight car to determine what merchandise is contained therein. He advised that the seals that they used are being obtained from a railrond transfer terminal on Route III. He advised that a trailer is used for the office and is usually not locked. POE stated he knows for a certainty this is where the seals are obtained by his wife and her accomplices because he has stolen them from there himself in the past.

POE advised that THOMAS FLAUGHER or FLOYER (bh) from the Madison-Granito City, Illinois area was cashing cashior's checks from the First National Bank of Grahois about one year ago and indicated that an individual by the name of JIM HAMPICA had been convicted in Calabona on Vederal charges in regard to this same group of checks which FLAUGHER was cashing. He advised that FLAUGHER is also associated with his wife, DIANE FOR.

He stated that this information goes back possibly about two years because the cars they were stealing were look models or older and they were replacing themserial plates on the cars for serial plates they obtained by buying just cars and transferring the serial plates to cars they had stolen.

FOR advised that he has some acqueintences with individuals comprising bergiary ring in the St. Louis, Missouri area, but has so specific information regarding burglaries committed by the group. He advised that he was well acquainted with MARVIN LYMWOOD EYR and JAMES LLOYD MC BRIDE. He advised that MC BRIDE was in the penitentiary with him at Jefferson City, Missouri. He stated that both MYE and MC BRIDE and other burglarers in the erea were working largely under the direction of BAY ADASSON, who lives presently in St. Louis, Missouri, and who was editor of the prison newspaper at Moberly, Missouri. He advised that ADAMSON handles dope, is involved in prestitution and other illegal activities, and controls MC BRIDE and others by suppling them with narcotics.

POE stated that ADAMSON dealt with TERRY (LNU), a Negro narcotics pusher, who was killed in St. Louis, several nonths ago. POE described TERRY us ADAMSON's "bit wan".

FUE advised that ADAMSON tried to set up BAY EVANS, a burglar who is presently incorcerated at the Menord Branch at one time. EVANS is a member of a family involved in burglaries in the St. Louis, Missouri, and Illinois area. POE also advised that BILL POLITE (ph) and SILLIE WINSLAW were associates of EVANS as was EYE and MC ERIDE.

It is to be noted that ATAMSON is engaged in a printing business in St. Louis, Missouri, and information has been received in the past that ATAMSON has been involved in the handling of counterfeit securities.

POE was interviewed regarding his knowledge of various back robberies and bank buiglaries, including the burglaries of the New Athen Savings and Loan Association. New Athens, Illinois, 4/10-13/70, and the robbery of the Lebsnon Trust and Savings Bank, Lebsnon, Illinois, 10/31/60. He advised that he had no specific information regarding any bank burglaries or bank robberies in the area.

He stated that he has never been involved in any armed robberies but that he has been picked up before by the Alton Police Department as a suspect.

He stated that he does not know anyone named JIM NEVILLE. He stated that possibly the individual is JIM NEBBLE (PH). He stated that he met this individual in Alton at the Sportsman's Club and that this individual used to run around with RALPH PAGE of Alton. COATNEY further stated that NEBBLE is not from Alton but that he is supposed to be living in the Peoria, Illinois area and is possibly connected with prostitutes in that area.

COATNEY advised that if someone had named him (COATNEY) as being involved in a bank robbery it is possible that the individual had him confused with a BILL COATES who lives in Alton. He stated that the police have occasionally pulled him in for questioning when they had heard that a robbery was committed by COATES and thought that the source meant COATNEY.

COATNEY further advised that a JIM WHITE of Wood River, Illinois, is reputed to have robbed a bank in southern Illinois about four years ago and is reputed to have robbed a bank in southeastern Missouri about three years ago. COATNEY believes that WHITE may have also been involved in robbery of albank in upper Alton.

The variant was refused on a charge of suspicion of stealing over \$50.

It would appear from the above that GUINAN was in custody at the time of captioned robbury, however, if further vorification is needed this could be obtained through the Mo. Dept. of Corrections at Jefferson City, No. which is covered by the NC Division.


