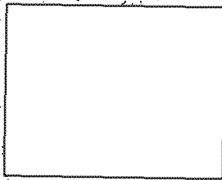

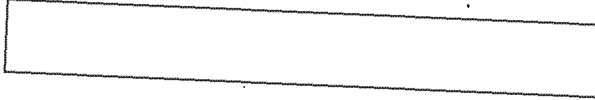

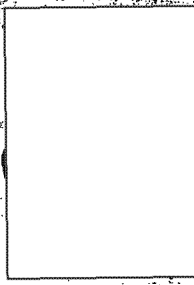

1. Headquarters can provide no additional guidance on CC CPSU Representatives abroad other than that forwarded in Reference A.

2. According to Reference B, the Station has tentatively identified one of the Soviet diplomats in [redacted] as the CC CPSU Representative. Since this individual was not named in Reference B, a Headquarters review of the files of Soviets most likely to hold this position has been made and from the information currently available to us, [redacted] (201-128117) appears to be this individual.

3. Although [redacted] present and past duties do not fit all the criteria set forth in Reference A, there are certain indicators that he is the CC CPSU Representative. Little is known of [redacted] in Cuba, where he was assigned as Second Secretary and Chief of the Consular Section from 1960 to 1969. Prior to that, however, [redacted] was a Consular Officer [redacted] from 1954 to 1956. Among his reported duties there, the following could be considered as background leading to his suspected current position:

- a) handled emigre and repatriation matters and was involved in activities requiring Spanish, which he and his wife speak reasonably well.
- b) believed to be active in the Colony's **NESTKOM**, (which in general is social rather than political, although the political element is ever-present. The **NESTKOM** Secretary is usually a Party activist who is responsible for making certain that no possible deviations from the Party line crop up in any **NESTKOM** discussions or activities.)

- c) reportedly became angry with a colleague who refused to prepare a speech commemorating GORKIY's birthday.
- e) wife supervised production of the Soviet publication, URSS.

4. In his current position as Counselor of Embassy, [redacted] enjoys apparent freedom of movement and is sufficiently high-ranking to be the CC CPSU Representative. In addition, no firm identification has ever been made [redacted]

[redacted] Although the Station reported in [redacted] - 18575, 29 June 1971, that [redacted] was believed to be a "likely candidate for new [redacted]", it would seem from information contained in Headquarters files that he is more likely the SC CPSU Representative. An excerpt from Reference C contains the following indicators:

During visits to the Soviet "Quinta" almost every week-end [redacted]

- a) lunched with the Ambassador,
- b) spent long periods reading, seated outdoors under the trees and remained generally aloof from other Soviets,
- c) was the only Soviet who addressed other Soviets as "Comrade", and
- d) his wife was said to treat wives of lower-ranking personnel in a brusque and authoritarian manner.

While the indicators cited above are not conclusive in themselves in establishing that [redacted] is the CC CPSU Representative, they do point up the possibility that he might be acting in that capacity.

5. We shall be interested to learn the identity of the Station's tentative CC CPSU Representative selection. In addition, from our review of the files mentioned in Paragraph 3, it seems that the most likely candidates [redacted]

[redacted] is [redacted] (201-236701), with either [redacted] (201-780352) or Boris [redacted] (201-247225) [redacted] We should also like to have the Station's thinking as to the identification of [redacted] his Deputy.

1. Since his move to the Residence/Club in mid-1970, AEBOOR has appeared to withdraw from almost all overt activity. Rarely does he appear on BILOCULAR and his daily routine is a complete mystery. In order to determine his present status, the BIBAFFLES were directed to run a surveillance on AEBOOR from Monday, 6 September through Tuesday, 14 September 1971. During this period his wife was away on home leave, thus giving him the opportunity to pursue a different life if he were so inclined. His overt subordinate in the cultural field, 201-220310, had left PCS without a replacement. Presumably his cover activities would be multiplied. Despite all this, AEBOOR maintained a spartan routine which left no clue about his present interests, activities, or responsibilities.

2. Most mornings (including Saturday and Sunday), he drove or walked to the Embassy, often buying a paper on the way. Once inside he stayed until about 1300 hours when he returned to the [redacted]. His lunch break was rarely longer than a half hour. He returned to the Embassy and stayed at least until 2000 hours, sometimes until 2300 hours. Upon leaving, he walked or drove directly to the [redacted] and never came out again during the night.

3. AEBOOR's only deviations from this schedule were an occasional trip to a neighbourhood shop to buy cold-cuts; one excursion to a leather-goods store to look at suitcases;

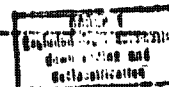

one attendance at a MEKNIGHT Embassy function; two trips to [ ] airport; and, surprisingly enough, a Sunday afternoon tour with 201-873887 and his wife to take pictures along the river front and drink beer in a [ ] cafe. (During this last excursion, the known KGB officer drove the GRU chauffeur and his wife.) The first trip to the airport was made in the company of several other high-ranking Embassy officials to greet an important transiting delegation. (See HABA-22399.) On the second trip AEBOOR was accompanied by 201-128117 (suspect KGB resident) and 201-790164 (chauffeur). On arrival, AEBOOR and his companions went up to the terrace to take photos of the Concorde as it landed for a two-day visit. They were joined by Mr. and Mrs. AELESION and 201-228494. Evidently, the KGB and the GRU groups went separately to photograph the same plane.

4. Twice during the period the BIBAFFLES felt that AEBOOR might have been checking for surveillance. Otherwise there were no incidents of note. Not once were the BIBAFFLES approached by local authorities with a request that they identify themselves.

5. In sum, we remain as much in the dark as before about AEBOOR. With every opportunity and reason in the world to lead a hectic pace, he spent the majority of his waking hours within the Embassy. During the days in question he received only one phone call even worth noting, one in connection with the [ ] scheduled for late September.

I.- SUBJECT

[redacted] was born in Moscow (U.S.S.R.), on the 20th of January 1928, [redacted], married to [redacted], born on September 20th, 1934, in Moscow, [redacted]. Subject is assigned as [redacted] of the U.S.S.R. Embassy [redacted]. He arrived in this country on the 27th of January 1968, taking up residence on [redacted] 5th Floor, Apt. "A" in the Federal Capital, [redacted] living at said address until the 7th of October 1969 when he moved to live at the [redacted].

[redacted] had been for a short time in [redacted] during the month of September 1958; in Havana in September 1961; in Quito in January and February 1962 and in Tijuana in September 1963. He was representative [redacted] during 1960 and 1964.

In view of the fact that subject lived separately from the rest of the Embassy personnel, his mission based on information was thus made easier.

It should be pointed out, that during his residence on [redacted] he was kept under surveillance through a technical penetration carried out by this Section.

As a result of the exploitation of these lines, as well as the Case "ASADO" (summer home) and information from the [redacted], certain details concerning his personality, private life and contacts have been ascertained.

Through thorough study of above mentioned sources, it is apparent that the [redacted] have certain differences, during which he is the object of vituperation from his wife [redacted] which Ivan thoroughly ignores to the great exasperation of his wife.

II.- PERSONALITY OF [redacted]

He is an introvert, clever, cautious and distrustful. He knows how to hide his feelings and he has an excellent self-control, showing violent feelings on very rare occasions. (See Section IV).

With relation to his cultural level, nothing much is known, as he has never been heard speaking on themes of general culture. When he speaks at social gatherings he is joking, using double meaning phrases (usually funny)

or he tells jokes. It is as though he were afraid to show that he takes things seriously, as though he were ashamed or frightened.

During the various opportunities when his wife is screaming all sort of improprieties at him he maintains absolute silence, seeming to be concentrating on one fixed idea, and letting all that [ ] says just slide off him.

He has been identified and known to belong to the [ ] [ ] is considered a high official in the embassy and of absolute trustworthiness [ ] [ ] being respected and feared by the rest of the embassy staff. He speaks perfect spanish.

He is present at all receptions with [ ] [ ] respectively), not only in his official position, but also in his private life, having a warm friendship between the three which is quite rare in the embassy circle. During his stay at the summer home, [ ] and his wife occupy the quarters reserved for the ambassador.

### III.- PERSONALITY OF [ ]

A certain duality of personality is apparent in her behavior. In her married life she shows herself to be intolerant and impetuous, arriving at absolute lack of control on various occasions, bringing forth continual marital quarrels.

On the contrary, in her social life, she shows herself as a very docile, cheerful woman, being the center of attraction in almost all the gatherings for her "lovely disposition" and gaiety, not only among the men but also their wives. (See section I).

[ ] is a woman brought up in the typical soviet atmosphere, subjected since childhood to a rigid political indoctrination in some juvenile organization and in school. She is not sufficiently intelligent to rid herself, even partially, of what she has been taught. She does not separate her affective life from the obligations that she, presumes, every <sup>good</sup> Communist citizens should have. It seems that she does not realize the importance of her husband's mission. She is not a woman who is attuned to her companion. She is not on the same wave length, she does not understand him. She harbors a concentrated and continuous resentment against him. Maybe this is due to his ironic, and keen and wounding sense of humour.



With regard to her surroundings, this woman has shown, on various opportunities, to feel antipathy and scorn for [ ] and its people, due probably to its leanings toward democracy, and therefore, contrary to her way of thinking. As she has shown not to possess much imagination, she takes as wonderful that which she has been taught. However, the reason for her poor matrimonial relations remains a mystery. Maybe one of the reasons, as stated above is her lack of understanding of her husband, so that one quarrel on top of the other has built a wall which cannot be breached.

In the company of her friends, [ ] has always shown herself to be pleasant, gay and uncomplicated. She has not always masked her marital problems, so that they are not a secret to the rest of the members of the embassy, who nevertheless make believe they know nothing about it, through consideration or whatever other motives they may have. On some occasions [ ] has taken the initiative to improve relations between the [ ] to no avail.

#### IV.- MODUS OPERANDI WHICH HAS SHOWN UP FROM SURVEILLANCE

During the shadowing of [ ] he has shown himself to be an expert in this matter. He is observant and his movements in the street are carried out carefully and ably- on many opportunities he has shaken off his shadows. He is an excellent driver, and he uses all sorts of ruses to draw off the agents on the job. This is proved below:

##### Shadowing on 23-5-69:

He drove his car down [ ] turned on 9 July going towards [ ] which was closed off for repairs. In the middle of the street were two signs which read: [ ] Subject disregarded the signs and continued straight ahead towards [ ] where transit was completely cut off, and he had to take 9 July again and comes to the [ ]

With this trick, [ ] wanted to learn whether he was being followed.

##### SHADOWING on 20-5-69:

He went into the [ ] approaches the counter, carries on a conversation with an employee, and vanishes without being observed in spite of close vigilance .

- Before going into a building of store, he looks in both directions and searches carefully.

- When he goes in his car, he drives slowly, but every so often, he steps on the gas, and then abruptly reduces speed, doing this various times.

--During all the shadowings carried out, subject always managed to go ahead on the yellow light, leaving his shadow generally facing the red light.

- On various occasions he went up one way streets.

**V.- CONTACTS**

It was ascertained that [redacted] arrived home very late at night and even at dawn, which is quite out of the ordinary with the rest of the diplomatic personnel. (See Annex 2).

This led to the supposition that subject was either leading a licentious life or carrying out clandestine activities. Therefore, a permanent surveillance was carried out during 24 hours for 20 days on his home, proving that he did in reality come home between 6 and 7 at times.

Fifteen days before his return to the U.S.S.R. for his leave, a surveillance and shadowing service was set up during all 24 hours, proving that subject did make clandestine contacts.

It was under these circumstances that on the 21/5/69, at 1200 hours, a contact was spotted. This occurred once again on the 23/5/69, at which time the "contact" was suspicious of being followed and he pulled quickly out of the area.

On the 18th of August of the present year, when a security agent who was carrying out his duties on the [redacted] address (improvement of the P.T.), spotted the above mentioned contact patrolling the zone; with the aid of a Policeman he was detained in order to be identified, his documents are the following:

After investigation was carried out it was established that subject did not live at said address and that his I.D. was not his.

Continuing the investigation it was learned that at [redacted] 7th floor, a certain [redacted] did live there, and that he worked at [redacted] and also in the firm [redacted] which was in the construction and sale of [redacted]

When [redacted] was visited, it was learned that this firm had gone out of business for some time.

Following investigation, it was learned at the administrative offices of the firm [redacted] the agent in charge of the investigation was waited by subject, who turned out to be:

It should be pointed out that in order to establish his activities and connections with [redacted], starting 22-10-69 a surveillance and shadowing was carried out on subject.

On the other hand, and as a result of the use of the clandestine microphones, it was learned that [redacted], maintained conversations with a person by the name of [redacted] who was a member of the directive Council of the Metropolitan Federation of Chess and the [redacted] Federation.

Beginning October 22nd of this year a surveillance and shadowing service was established to determine his activities and possible contacts with [redacted]

**VI. CONCLUSIONS**

With reference to the [redacted] the following conclusions have been reached:

- a) He is a diplomatic officer who carries out his professional work efficiently, showing at all times great sagacity when carrying out public contacts and relations, avoiding on various opportunities with ingenuity and ability the shadowing detail assigned to him.
- b) With reference to his relations and activities within the Embassy, it is observed that he carries a lot of weight over the rest of the personnel, as he is given deferential attention and respect not only at official but private functions within the circle.
- c) He is a person who is always busy, on the go all day and on into the late hours of the night.
- d) His married life is not harmonious, due to the character of his wife who is temperamental and impetuous and not tolerant toward subject. It is estimated that these misunderstandings are linked to his activities outside of normal working hours, which take him away from home, as well as, the indifference and silence with which her recriminations are received.
- e) With reference to his contacts, mentioned in this report, the corresponding investigations are being carried out to determine how far they reach and their importance.

1. We have kept you up to date on AEBOOR's sudden move and the subsequent termination of AELANYARD. At the present time, we still do not know whether or not the story of a sudden transfer [redacted] was in reality the basis for the move or if a compromise of the operation was the actual cause. As we pointed out in our original cable, our immediate thought was that perhaps the [redacted] had caused all AEKICK types to "pull in" and that perhaps AEBOOR was simply following orders. Subsequent investigation, however, tended to discredit this thought.

2. The AELANYARD transcripts reveal that AEBOOR did indeed contemplate the move several days before we actually had wind of it. His wife did not like the idea and complained to him about the move. AEBOOR also told his landlord in advance of his move. There is also evidence that AEBOOR was in somewhat regular contact with the [redacted] Embassy and although we were not certain, it appeared that he was anxious to learn if his visa had been granted. In any case, on 28 September 1969, AEBOOR and wife checked out of their apartment.

3. Shortly thereafter, we made a physical check of the interior of the apartment. Everything seemed to be in order. There was no evidence whatsoever that the technical end of the operation had been tampered with. As we said before, it functioned up until and after AEBOOR vacated.

4. We have not been able as yet to establish direct social contact with AEBOOR. Both Nina T. MARGANDE and Paul W. LEVERONE (who have legitimate reason to seek him out) have tried, but to date, to no avail. Our hope has been to have AEBOOR actually tell us of his plans - will he indeed be transferred [redacted] Our original thought was that the [redacted] could readily determine if he had indeed applied for a visa to that country. As you know, we struck out here also.

5. The fact is that as of this writing, we do not know whether AEBOOR's move was routine and innocent or if indeed there was something sinister involved. If AEBOOR does indeed pick up and move [redacted] we shall, of course, be somewhat relieved. However, this will not answer categorically the major question - was the operation compromised? It would appear that regardless of what happens to AEBOOR, we shall never know the actual reason for his move. However, for what it is worth, the evidence here does not point toward a compromise.

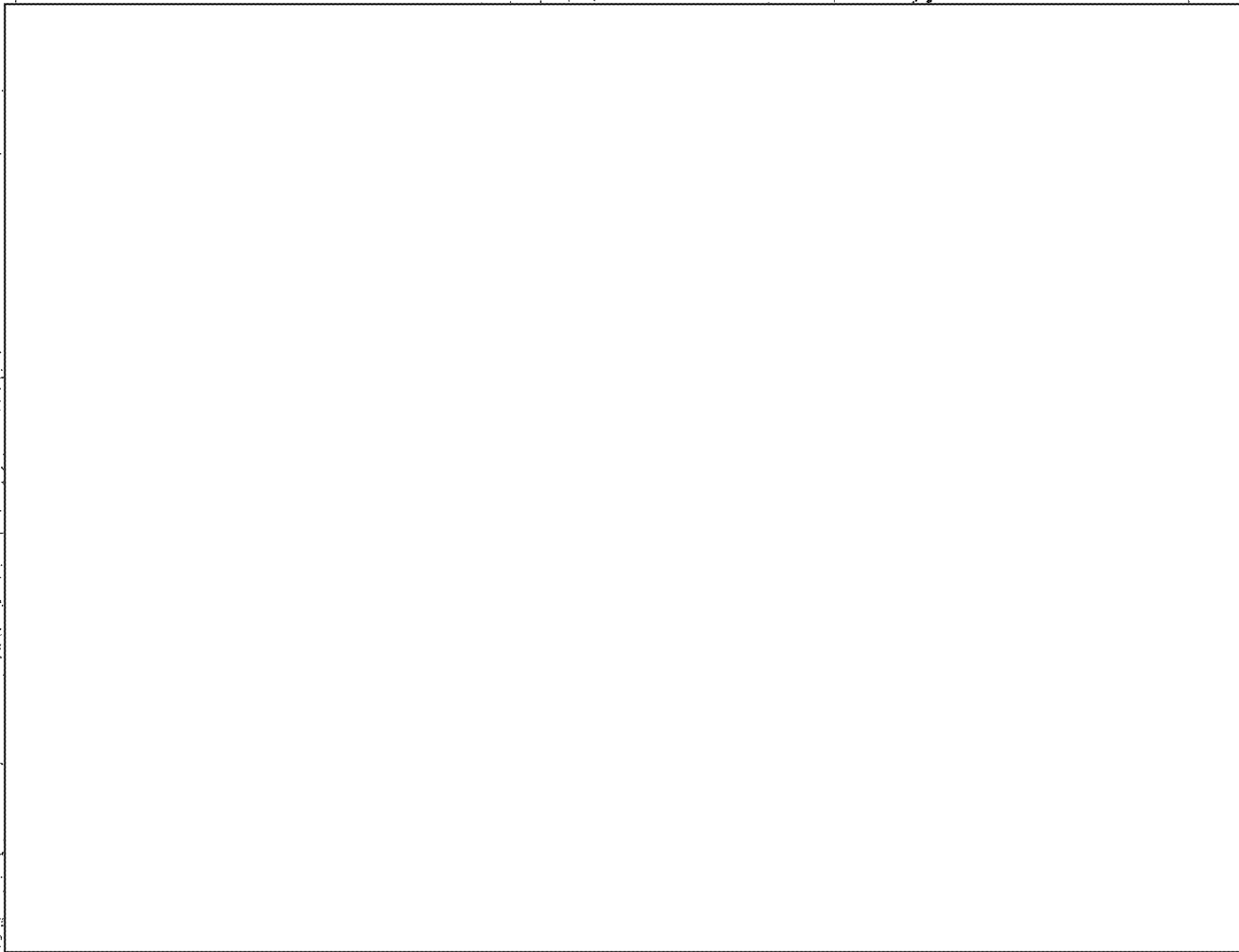

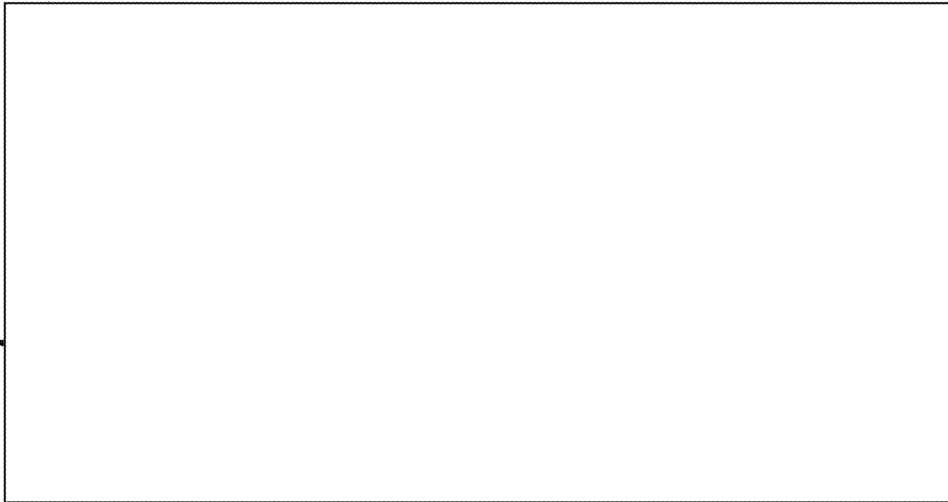

The detailed analysis of the Station's operational efforts against some of the priority FJSTEAL targets and the suggestion that perhaps AEBOOR offered the best immediate operational promise and warranted special attention was reviewed and discussed by the interested officers; it should come as no surprise to Headquarters that there is really little divergence of opinion, not only as to the priority target, but also insofar as operational approach and conduct is concerned. We would like to correct the apparent Headquarters impression that the Station was negligent in the follow-up of operational opportunities and was waiting for the FJSTEALs to take the initiative insofar as future contacts were concerned. We believe Station efforts have been as aggressive as possible in the existing operational climate, and if we were remiss, it was in failing to report in detail the various negative results of what we consider normal operational efforts.</p> <p>2. AEBOOR was selected as one of the priority Station targets for the simple reason that three officers had direct access to him through Identity; once he accepted the invitation to Paul W. LEVERONI's home he was moved up to the top of the priority list since it was hoped that continued and rather frequent contact could be maintained for assessment and operational purposes. up the first social contact (experience has shown that the FJSTEALers here will not take the initiative and must be actively pursued) but a number of conversations (both face to face and by phone) ended up in the vague promise on the part of Subject that "we must get together soon". In the interim the Station tightened the coverage of AEBOOR by putting AELANIARD on a 24-hour-a-day basis for a little over two weeks and by conducting full coverage surveillance for about one week. Our reasoning behind this acting was as follows: such intensive coverage would possibly permit us to spot a likely place where we could inject an access agent; it would give us a better "feel" of his daily activity; it might uncover one or more of his clandestine contacts. The results of the effort, while far from solving our problems, did give us a wealth of information which should help us in our operational planning once AEBOOR returns to his station.

3. The distaff side of the target was not ignored, and Nina T. MARGANDE managed to spend some time in conversation with AEBOOR's wife during a get-together of Identity on 21 May 1969. As a result of this meeting the groundwork has been laid for a follow-up by MARGANDE; despite the fact that the wife was at first cool and then lukewarm to the idea of getting together for a shopping excursion, we will do everything possible to bring such a meeting about and try have MARGANDE become the wife's "confidante", if this is possible. (In order to permit MARGANDE to pursue this contact in the most natural manner and to give her a chance to meet and assess other FJSTEALer wives, she has also become a member of Identity.)

4. Until his departure for home leave AEBOOR was the primary FJSTEAL target and will continue in this position after his return until we can reach a decision regarding future action. There is one thing that should be kept in mind, however; and that is the fact that all of the FJSTEALers are reserved in their dealings with members of IMPURE. It seems that it is possible to get some of the FJSTEALers to accept an invitation, even to a private home, but to try to develop such a contact into a continuing social relationship is a much harder proposition. Leland C. KROULD's experience with 201-313506 followed this pattern, and despite KROULD's efforts to continue and follow up what seemed to be the beginning of a good relationship, nothing came of the attempt; Stephen M. GARSIDE twice tried to utilize a natural opportunity to get together with 201-820310, only to be put off, as he was in an approach to 201-025485; Paul W. LEVERONE tried on several occasions to arrange a dinner with 201-183943, only to be put off (and this despite the fact that 201-183943 maintains extensive social contacts with non-WOLADY types). 201-025485 has expressed an interest in social contact, and since he is a senior type who should not have to check out and obtain approval for his social activity, we hope that he will not conform as closely to the pattern. This is not the time or place to examine the possible reasons for the FJSTEALer attitude; it is merely mentioned to demonstrate that we are fighting an uphill (although not a hopeless) battle, a battle that we intend to win by fair means or foul.
