According to information dated 1/9/44, he was again arrested by the Portuguese police and place in Peniche prison.

The following list of names was compiled from the WATTEL report. According to the few exceptions (noted in the text), the information on each person is substantially WATTEL'S own comment, colored by his prejudices and tailored here and there to fit his role of double agent. It is probably full of errors and falsehoods.

WATTEL side these contacts between the months of December, 1942, and September, 1943. They are numerous and varied, ranging from hotel chambermaids to "an intimate friend of Salasar's". Some of these people he employs, many of them use him; and he is, or was, paid by all; by us, by the Gormans, and in services, perhaps even in money, by the Free French, the Wichy French, and the Lisbon Police. The result was inevitable; en September 18, 1943, we severed all connections with him.

MARCEL CELESTIN CHEY, alias JEAN REHAULT, ARTHUR PATTELS

Height, 1.70 m.; weight, 64 kgs.; brown hair and blu. eyes; age 36-Speaks no foreign languages. Has a common-law wife, Antoinette Lhermine, and a small daughter, in France.

According to British reports, subject was born in Parision June 3, 1707 1907. Claims to have been a stock broker in Paris before the war: probable worked for the 2s Bureau. During the war was attached to the Himistry of Agriculture, through the influence of Queille. In 1940 he was in southern France, then went into biding in Toulouse, for unknown reasons. He has never explained satisfactorily the large sums of money which he had in his possession when he finally escared to Barcelona on September 5, 1942, and then to Lisbon, where he opened an account with the Danco Finte a Softomior. Subject arrived in Portugal with a Nicaraguan passport, yet professed to be a Belgian. He was arrested October 21, and released from prison six wooks later with the help of Horonha; was then engaged by the Gorman Intelligence service. Later, he also worked for us, through Gorlier. Subject lived for a time at the Hotel Rosa, Caldas da Rainha, then the Hotel Europe, Lisbon. Next, he moved to Ho. 27, rua Actor Isidoro, grunnd floor; right. He has also lived on the run Trombeta. Subject was rearrested, apparently as a communist agent but very probably at the instigntion of the British, on July 31, 1943, and lodged in Aljube prison. When last heard from, in September, he had been released, was bearer of a German passport, and had been promised by the Germans the job of counse

Only trace of such a man is the report, dated May, 1741, of a Col. Arceau, an ex-Covernor of the French colonies, who was anti-Vichy, pessiless and ready to serve anywhere, but was not to be trusted.

He was appointed upon Knefper's arrival; he is in constant touch with his Legation, but his instructions come directly from the central service. When the "big Chief" was in Lisbon, subject was seen in his company. Burckhardt is his "right arm"; he confers with "Frits"; Ostins, of the Vichy Legation, whose guest he was at the farewall dinner for d'Amade, is under his orders and sees him daily. Subject is married and spends his week-ends at Villa Bella, Estoril (Tel: 608), a house known to be rented to a German couple and used as a meeting-place.

LAGENY, Madame

Wattel and Chatel both urged him to contact Honnier, and Wattel persuaded him to sttend Optim's farewell dinner for d'Amade, of the Wichy Legation.

LERRUH

Mattel advises egainst contacting him; states that subject may be leaning toward the Briffish or he say be seting under orders from Chatal or Gorlier. His position is not at all clear.

THEMANH, Brich Micheann?

In June was interested with Wattel in getting some merchandise into Spain.

LICES PLATES

(CDT) car No. HE 10-20 parked at Horonia's door is registered in the name of Helmatt Robert, German Consular Secretary.

CD car Ho. 1ACO2132 is said to belong to the "Big Chief", Wattel's boss and Colonel Schmidt's assistant.

LIMAS (Bro) (Enilla da Gracía Masa o Linas) cos Portigal

Wattel's good friend, for some time, at least. Wattel says: "I don't think that Mrs. Limes is a very bright person, but she is well-tred, has good culture, and a very strong will." He culims to have trained her, to have "moral power" over ner, and maintains she is a person devoted to the Allied cause who has, indirectly, furnished information to the British. St Wattel's urging, she met Horonne and was enwared by him as a German agent, Wattel insisting, however, that she reveal to him the work she did for the Masis. Buronha planned to send her to Brasil, where she has an uncle; while waiting for the visa she was to watch the British and Americans in Lisbon. Subject speaks French fluently and was recommended by Wattel to Morlier, of Free French Forces, for Africa. Her mother fights with Wattel over money matters.

LORENCO, Ca::4.

Is reported to have had two P.W.D.E. Inspectors at Oporto, Games and Haloo, arrested for differing with him and Capt. Oliveirs on political matters.

Comerino Con Cot Portugal

Head of the organisation that forged Contuguese massocies. Subject, a one-time police informer, is reported to be a communist; his organisation is believed to have been financed by the French communist party and to have been working for the Allied cause. He was a tiplogetic courier, treveling to Frence every month, where he sold the passports to various Legations for the purpose of getting men in and out of the country. In this he was sometimes sided by his friend, the Portuguese Consul at Marseilles. He once offered Wattel 50 passports for AO,000 escudos. When arrested, in April, he refused to name the French officials involved, or the printers and engravers in Lisbon who had forged the documents. He admitted his contacts

with the Belgians, however. The organisation was betrayed by Victor Contact Subject is asserted as confiding and talketive, but an unpleasant man. was released from prison on June 16.

Subject lives in Wattel's apertment. She is pro-German and econocited with the Gorman Intelligence Service. She had been in Berlin before the par-

He is A frequent visitor at Horonha's, who acts as his intermediary with certain Portuguese firms. Thus, on May 6, there was a meeting in Horonha's office between subject, Moronia, a Portuguese business man and an Oriental, probably a Japanese, who spoke Portuguese very well. On June 8, while Moronha was in Madrid, subject is known to have phoned that city and told the person on the wire to stop everything and hold the documents, he would be going to Bercelone that night. Subject had many conversations with Moronia upon the latter's return from Madrid.

MOTIVIER

In May, Wettel reported that subject was planning to get in touch with Algiers where his presence would be velcome. Subject left for Vichy scortly ofterword.

MOOURS. General

Wattel and ordered in June to contact subject at Batalha; Governor Chatel would have introduced him. Gereens believed, at the time, trat they could get subject to return to Vichy.

Both Mattel and British agree that subject recruité agents for the German Intelligence Service. He first interviewed Mattel in rison is October, 1942; charged him a fee of 20,000 escudos for his release, then got him to join the German organisation, under pressure, Wattel maintains. Later, in March, he similarly recruited Wattel's friend, Mrs. Limas. Shortly afterward, he appeared greatly worried by the actions of the police who suddenly began arresting Gestapo agents.

Subject was reported at a very early date to be interested in the commercial activities of the Germans and to be buying various products for them. In Pabruary he was commissioned by the German Embassy to buy 400 tons of eoffee. When it was ready to be shipped, subject ciained to have sufficient influence with Lisbon harbor authorities to arrange for the ship's departure withou's a *navicert* and, in April, when it was finally decided to send this soffee overland to Spain, he suggested the "landcort" by applied for in Oporto where the Allies were less observant. Once, in Wattel's presence, he received an urgent call from a Mr. Bedon (Redon?) and hurried over to Ho. 34, Avenida 24 de Julho, the head office of the Portuguese Air Mavigation Co. where, later, he told of meeting members of important Cormon firms (one driving a CD car No. HE1020) and discussing with them a matter involving commercial documents that was to bring him 100,000 escudos. Then, in April, he was reported to be trying to ship 200 tens of whele oil to Spain. Bruno Mayer was a frequent visitor and it is possible that subjects trip to Madrid in June was on some business errand for this man. Subject often acts as intermidiary for Mayer in his contacts with Purtuguese firms. May 6, for example, in subject's office were present: Mayer, a Portuguese business man, and an Oriental, possibly a Japanese, who spoke Portuguese very wall. In June subject negotiated the purchase, by the Germans, of a product called Banacao (probably canned caseo) the seller being L.J. Rosenbusch Hellautt and the intermediary Philip Syltzer. The merchandise was to be delivered at Vigo, in transit for Switzerland. Subject, Wattel adds, planned to remove a cargo of cacao from a Portuguese ship in the Tagus, substitute a false cargo, insure it with a German firm, then have the ship souttled while en route to Bibeo.

Subject appears to have been in prison in February, but whether this was as a prisoner himself, or as legal aid to prisoners, the reports do not

make alear. In prison he heard a certain Jose Eatesta tell of a pro-Ailied group that planned sebotage in the event of a German invasion. Wattel reports that subject revealed this information to the police, which resulted in the arrest of Jose Batesta, Condes, and others. He is reported to have also met in prison a certain Eugenic Ascue, a Cuban under detention for dealing in contraband, and to have given him some dollar checks. Subject is a friend of Capt. Jose Carrela d'Almeida of the Police and is often seem in his company. Was involved in the Captein's errest of Loureiro in the "Portuguese Passport" case. Subject wanted Wattel to contact David Costodio, a young American expecting to return to the United States and once asked him to approach a certain young man of 20 who sold lace in the streets.

In March, subject was visited by a group of Frenchmen, one of whom is believed to be a member of the Legation; and another Frenchmen was seen at his effice on April 19. Subject calls several times a week at the Brasilian Embassy. He is frequently observed at the Care Cristal, usually with two or three others, but sometimes with an Italian. He is often in the company of a man who lives at No. 32, Travessa do Cabral, or nested with yet another, at the Cafe Micola.

Wattel had subject followed on his trip to Maurid, to try to pin on him the charge of smuggling money, but was unsuccessful. In another report that is not at all clear, Wattel claims that subject was connected with something, or someone, called "American Joint" for ne noticed a statement of 17,000 escudos.

Wattal, in his description of subject's office, points out that the elients and the informants use the same waiting room, therefore accord be sewretly photographed. Six o'clock would be the best hour. Subject shares the office with several colleagues, one of whom, a dermanophobe, has the room next to subject's, and could be bribed to let one enter and listen to conversations through the thin partition.
