3. Finally Norwegian personnel have repeatedly expressed their personal desire service in Norway and final selection these men to remain so this theater made to appreciable extent on representation their commitment forthcoming Norwegian operation. Cancellation operation and making them for operations at time German collapse would create serious morale problem and certainly factor to be considered.

3. USSTAF has been repeatedly warned difficulties securing personnel for POW project and failure fulfill commitment while extremely embarrassing would be far less so than to go back on Norwegian commitment.

4. Therefore recommend:

A. That SO personnel fulfill Norwegian commitment.

B. If impossible obtain SO's we will contact SHAF and USSTAF immediately and explain situation, suggesting that they make available 1 company airborne troops. We in turn will provide instruction, supplies, briefing and small nucleus of Jedburgh type officers. We can probably get together here approximately 6. If this plan is agreeable suggest earmarking from all sources as many Jedburgh type officers as possible for this operation. Have in mind Captains Barata Pietsch, Dussacq, Lieuts. Lo Blanc, Levitine and Sanchez; and if they have radio training, Sgts. Borada, Klemak and Skokoski, all understood to be in Washington at the present time. Sgs. Robert Anstett and Lucien Conoin should also be held if available.
