The records in the District Office, Immigration and Naturalization Service, 3915 Biscayne Boulevard, which were checked on 12 March 1962, were found to contain file #A-12 437 215 pertaining to one Carlos HERNANDEZ (Sanchez), who arrived in the United States at Miami, Florida on 23 February 1961. The file shows that this person was born on 15 October 1939 at Havana, Cuba; that he was a Cuban national; that he formerly resided at Calle 10 #460, Vedado, Havana, Cuba; that he expected to reside at 1551 Pennsylvania Avenue, Miami Beach, Florida; that his normal occupation was student; that he was single and that he could not return to Cuba for "political" reasons. He was paroled into the United States on an indefinite basis under Section 212 (d)(5) of the Nationality Act.

On 11 September 1961, the fingerprints of this person were submitted by the Immigration and Naturalization Service to the Headquarters of the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, D. C. and a reply was received stating that no prior arrest data was located.

CREDIT:

The records of the Credit Bureau of Greater Miami, 160 N. E. 4th. Street, which were checked on 12 March 1962, were found to contain no record in the name of the SUBJECT.

POLICE:

The records of the Miami Police Department and of the Dade County Public Safety Department, which were checked on 5 March 1962, were found to contain no record in the name of the SUBJECT.

POLYGRAPH INTERVIEW

No. 2525

No. 2525 was afforded a polygraph test on 19 May 1960. Testing was conducted in the English language.

The test covered routine security questions checking Subject's bona fides, vulnerability to blackmail, possible Communist sympathies, possible intelligence background or connections, and overall truthfulness of biographic statements. Specific questions covering possible engagement in homosexual activities were included during testing subsequent to admissions by Subject that he, at age 17-18, feared homosexual tendencies.

RESULTS

Analysis of the test indicates no apparent attempts at deception by Subject to the relevant test questions. Subject does not appear to have actually engaged in any homosexual acts. There were no responses indicative of deception regarding homosexual activity.

Members of Communist Party: (Divided into two groups - the old and the new.)

Old Members:

MATINELLO, Juan: Founder and chief of the Party. An individual of good position, he entered the Party out of frustration. He has been to the Soviet Union several times and is one of the big intellectuals of America (continent).

ORDOKI: Principal figure in the party's first days. Was even a member of the Comintern in the U.S.R. At the moment he is very much in the shadows and does not appear in anything official, but it is well-known that behind the scenes he is an important figure.

LAZARO Pena: Leader of the workers (C.T.C.) during Batista reign, and "Delivered" them to the dictator. It is said that it is he who actually manipulates David SALVADOR.

BLAS, Roca: Minister w/o portfolio during the first term of Batista. Communist from the beginning.

RODRIGUEZ, Carlos Rafael: Number 1 Communist intellectual of Cuba. He is a newer Communist than the others so far mentioned, having joined in late 1938 or early 1939. He is the counsellor of Fidel and Che. He has a document which allows him to enter any government office he chooses.

New Members:

CASTRO, Raul: Chief of the Armed Forces.

GUEVARA, Che: Director of the BANCO NACIONAL.

SARDINAS, Lalo: Chief of the Tiendas del Pueblo.

GARCIA, Calixto: Military Chief of Oriente.

ESCALONA, Defunidio: Military Chief of Pinar del Rio.

FUNEZ, Jimenez: Director of INRA.

SANTOS, Pinos: Chief of the economists of INRA.

SANTOS, Rios: Chief of Agriculture of INRA.

MEDINA, Gualdo: Member of the INRA Directorate.

CIELO FUEGO, Osmani: Brother of Camila. Communist since his university days. He is Minister of Public Works. His wife is also a Communist.

VALDOS, Ramito: Chief of Cuban G-2.

Cuban Intelligence Services

CRENS, Eduardo: G-2. Infiltrated by OOR Group (MRT) and provides us with information.

FAMI, Jose: 21 years of age. Member of the A.C.U. (Accem Catolica Universitaria). However, he feels very closed in there. It is felt that he might be an informant and hence is being surveilled by the A. C. U.

de la CONCEPCION, Octavio (Tavito): 23 years of age, fought in the Second East Front "Frank PAIS", and was a lieutenant. A good person, but according to most recent reports there is some suspicion.

IANDA, Alberto: "Communist" who was a member of the Caballeros de Colon (Catholic organization) and who at the moment acts like a Communist. This individual lives a block from my home (in 21 almost at the corner of 14). He tried to steal my pistol on the grounds that he was of the G-2. I talked to him about the rural commandos w/o knowing that he was a Communist. It is possible that he gave a report to the Party based on his conversations with me. He is an individual of second category who I believe is capable of doing anything to rise in the ranks or to get ahead.

DIAZ, Comandante Raul Arguelles: Chief of the D. I. E. (Department of Rebel Investigation). I had various indirect contacts with him during the revolution. I want to say here that he was the person who got me released from jail and then I was able to leave Cuba (see page 9, #37 of the questionnaire).

PIPERO, Comandante: See attachment #1. (Chief Paul's Personal Secret Service).

VALDOS, Ramito: See attachment #1 (Chief G-2).
