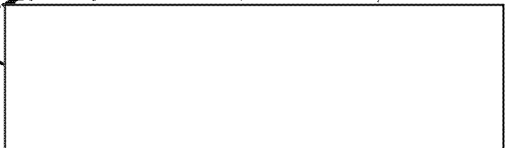

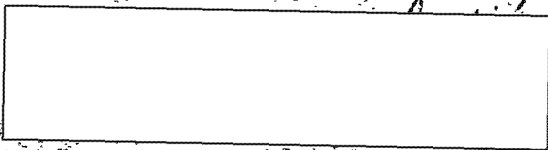

REF : Your memorandum dated 23 Nov 1959 - CD/CO Case 31785

1. As you were previously advised, Dun & Bradstreet had no available information on either of the subject concerned. However, [redacted] has provided the following preliminary information.

2. For background [redacted] we refer to the New York Times, 31 August 1959 and the Daily American, Rome, 9-10 November 1958. One of the directors, also described as being in charge of administrative affairs, Enrico Ranzel-Mantella, was recently in the US and expects to return to New York City about 17 Jan 1960.

3. The address of Perainlex is Dufourstrasse 11, Basel (office transferred from Bern to Basel in 1956). They plan to open a New York City office in January 1960. Capital: One million French Francs. Officers: Dr. Ferenc Nagy, President; Fritz Schurch, Vice President; Dr. Ernst W. Infeld, Delegate; Dr. Ernst Felast; Dr. Ernst Kellerer.

4. We will forward additional information as it becomes available. We are also trying to obtain information from the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and National Association of Manufacturers.

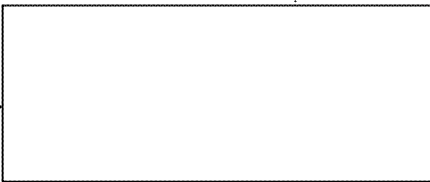

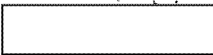
1. Attached for your retention is a brochure on subject organizations which was received by National Association of Union-carrers about early November 1959. A-2442
