15. SUMMARY: (S) Source reports receiving information through "chain of informants", which includes trusted individuals in CUBAN Armed Forces, relating to a security leak in the US. Allegedly, all saboteurs that are apprehended upon arriving in CUBA are arrested because w/a individual in US alerts GOC regarding number of saboteurs, how, when and where they will arrive in CUBA. (NFIA)

A/H COMMENT: "Chain of Informants" include (1) friend of Source, who is employed by telephone company, (2) student, who is friend of Source and is a member of the [redacted] HABANA CITY, and (3) member of CUBAN Navy stationed at [redacted] Province, who is brother of student. Apparently, naval personnel are original Sources.
