[REDACTED] mentioned that he left Germany to go to Vietnam but that he is, at the moment, unsure that this assignment will occur. [REDACTED] stated that a determination as to whether he goes to Vietnam should be reached in January of 1970. If [REDACTED] does go to Vietnam, he will send for SUBJECT in the early part of 1970.</p> <p>AGENT'S NOTES: Attention is invited to Agent Report by the undersigned, dated 10 September 1969, Subject as above, wherein [REDACTED] intention to marry SUBJECT is reported.
