SA RICHARD S. CLARK

Conducted inquiries at Tapachula, Chiapas, Mexico, regarding VICTOR COHEN, concerning whom one ERNESTO FLORES LUNA directed a letter to Attorney General ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

SA MATTHEW D. CRAWFORD, JR.

Interviewed Dr. EDUARDO BORRILL NAVARRO concerning allegations by one SALVADOR DIAZ VERNON regarding associations of OSWALD in Mexico City with SILVIA TIRADO DE DURAN and officials of the Cuban Embassy.

SA NATHAN L. FERRIS

Received from informants [MEX-18] and [MEX-19] several reports concerning reactions and speculation within the American Communist Group in Mexico (ACGM) concerning the assassination and OSWALD's visit to Mexico. Among ACGM associates mentioned by informants were CHARLES SMALL, KURT ODENHEIM, ELIZABETH CATLETT MORA and JOSEPH and REVA FRANK BERNSTEIN.

Received several reports from informants [MEX-46] with respect to the background of PEDRO GUTIERREZ VALENCIA and inquiries relating to other aspects of investigation in Mexico.

SA JOSEPH B. GARCIA

Handled liaison with the Mexican Ministry of Government, receiving copies of documents and data from Licenciado (Attorney) LUIS ECHEVERRIA, Acting Minister, and the Sub-Director of the Department of Immigration, Licenciado RAFAEL HERNANDEZ OCHOA. Also handled liaison with the Mexican Federal Security Police and arranged for delivery of a copy of the signed statement of SILVIA TIRADO DE DURAN by Captain FERNANDO GUTIERREZ BARRIOS.
