SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD

The purpose of this memo is to set down a chronological record of phone calls to and from the Bureau in connection with instant case in order that such a summary will be readily available in one place.

11/22/63 Telephone call to Assistant to the Director ALAN H. BELMONT for the purpose of advising that the Mexican Government was closing the border in an effort to prevent the escape of the assassin of President KENNEDY. This information had been received from MEX-56 ~~(S)~~ (u)

11/22/63 Phone call to Assistant to the Director BELMONT to advise him that Ambassador MANN was most interested in having someone from this office proceed by Navy plane to Dallas for the purpose of carrying to Dallas transcripts of the CIA intercepts of conversations on the telephones of the Cuban and Soviet Embassies and photographs of an individual who had visited these Embassies, this individual believed at that time to be LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Mr. BELMONT approved the travel of SA ELDON D. RUDD on the U. S. Navy Attache's plane to Dallas for this purpose. RUDD departed Mexico City on the night of 11/22/63 and returned from Dallas to Mexico City on the evening of 11/23/63. ~~(S)~~ (u)

11/25/63 Telephone call to Mr. BELMONT to advise him that Ambassador MANN was requesting the State Department to send a Bureau representative completely conversant with the OSWALD case to Mexico City for a few days. This was followed up by a cable to the Bureau on that date. ~~(S)~~ (u)
