In response to referenced Dallas airtel, Dallas is advised that in connection with Thomas Harvey, Legat, London advised by airtel 12/10/64 that a letter was directed to J. A. Rawles on 11/12/64 requesting that Rawles again get in touch with Legat, London. As of 12/10/64 Legat, London received no reply from Rawles, however, it is noted Rawles is a seaman and is at sea a considerable part of the time. Legat, London indicated, from past experience, that in all probability Rawles would communicate with Legat, London and this matter is being followed.

Legat, Mexico has furnished the Bureau appropriate results of investigation in connection with Dr. Ricardo Saldana DeAyllon which will be furnished to Dallas by separate communication.

Legat, Mexico has also advised that in connection with Jorge Barragan E., this matter is being followed with the Mexican Federal Security Police.

For the information of Dallas, it was noted no reference was made to the lead concerning Antilin Peris which
