He has been arrested eleven times in connection with various fraudulent operations and at the present time is serving a four and one-half year sentence in prison at Stade, West Germany. The BfV's reference to BUSKE's data on the East German Intelligence Service appears to refer to the comment made by BUSKE in the second paragraph of his letter to the Attorney General dated May 6, 1964

It appears from the Bfy information that BUSKE's reliability is questionable. However, the Bfy has been requested to arrange for an interview of him to obtain details of what he has to say and to get this information in a signed statement if possible. They have also been asked to provide the information which BUSKE furnished on March 17, 1964
