On 2/6/64, informants reported that REVA and JOSEPH BERNSTEIN claimed that they had been in Mexico for one month. Informants believed this to be a lie, which they could not explain, and pointed out that similar lies had been told them last year by the BERNSTEINS (By previous report received 2/5/64, informants pointed out that REVA and JOSEPH BERNSTEIN, had arrived in Mexico City on 2/2/64 and were staying at the Sevilla Hotel. Their plans allegedly included a trip to Zihuatanejo by air on 2/7/64, during which time they would leave their car in the Sevilla Hotel garage.

In conversation with informants, REVA BERNSTEIN stated that the strange thing with the Kennedy assassination was that she and her husband were visited by two newspaper reporters and by the Canadian "secret service" (regarding the use of the Cuban mail drop which they had utilized in Canada) but that neither local, state nor national police of the United States questioned them. Informants received the impression that Cuban matters are not a thing of the past so far as the BERNSTEINs are concerned.
