On 2/6/64, HILARIO ROJAS furnished the writer a slip of paper on which he stated was noted the names of the Cuban woman and the Cuban man and the American who came to Cozumel. He stated he found this note under the

innersole of a pair of shoes which he had bought in Cozumel. He stated that the notebook must still be with SOLIS in Cozumel.

All of the above have been placed in exhibit envelopes for this file.

MEX-33 advised on 2/10/64 that HILARIO ROJAS had arrived at Chilardi 665 prior to one year ago and that he was supposed to have been a mechanic and a truck driver. It was not known at Chilardi 665 where ROJAS had moved to. This is important since ROJAS stated he moved away from the Chilardi address following his return from Cozumel to get away from the Cubans. His return from Cozumel was apparently around August, 1963.
