Dear John, PHOTOGRAPH HIRAKOVA You may remember this name figures in the Warren Report as the Intourist guide provided for Lee OSWALD on his arrival in Moscow in October 1959. We think your headquarters may be interested to know that SHIRAKOVA has come to our notice as the friend of two British brothers who first visited the Soviet Union in 1960. SHIRAKOVA and a male guide joined the party with which the brothers were travelling at the Russian border. One of the brothers, who has pursued the friendship more than the other, considers he made the running, not SHIRAKOVA. He claims that relations between them have become affectionate, but are platonic. In fact since he first met SHIRAKOVA she has married and had a child, and our source visits their home when he goes to the Soviet Union. They also maintain a steady correspondence. 3. Taiter the birth of her daughter in October 1963, SHIRAKOVA, now Mrs. ZMITROOK, wrote that she had left Intourist and was employed as a teacher of English in a Moscow teachers' training college. 4. The two brothers last visited the ZMITROOKS at their home in a new housing estate in Moscow in August 1965. One of the things Rima showed them was an album of coloured post-cards of places in the U.S.A. which she claimed had been sent her by an American in return for money she had lent him when he was visiting the Soviet Union and ran short of funds. Unfortunately our source was not able to discover the name of the American or anything about him.
