On 1/14/68. NY 1519 S* a highly confidential and sensitive source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that on that date a Mrs. MARINA PORTER, Dallas, Texas, was in contact with her father, ALEKSANDR IVANOVICH MEDVEDEV, Apartment 43, Obvodney Kanal 80, Leningrad, USSR. Mrs. PORTER identified herself as Mrs. KENNETH PORTER and is apparently the widow of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

SECRET

In addition to being in contact with her father, Mrs. PORTER was in contact with her sister TANYA and a brother PETR. Mrs. PORTER indicated that she has three children: MARINA, six years old; RACHEL, age 4 and MARK age $l\frac{1}{2}$. She indicated she has forgotten much of her Russian and that she will be 27 years of age on 7/17/68. She advised that her husband, KENNETH PORTER, is 29. She inquired if her relatives in the USSR received a package that she had sent two years ago. They advised that such a package had been received. She indicated that her husband and children do not speak Russian.

Mrs. PORTER invited her father to visit her in the United States, as her guest and that she will pay for his transportation. She suggested that if he wanted to come to the United States, he should write to the U.S. Embassy. Mrs. PORTER was advised that her father had recently married. They all expressed their mutual well being and affection for one another.

Mrs. PORTER stated that she is healthy and very happy. She indicated that she loves her husband and he loves her. She described him as tall, black hair and beautiful eyes. She stated that she has a very nice home consisting of three bedrooms, two baths, a kitchen, dining room and a large garden.
