THAT ONE MORNING BETWEEN 4-6 SEP 63(EXACT DATE SHE COULD NOT REMEMBER) AT APPROXIMATELY 0900-0930 HOURS, UPON DEPARTING HOTEL ROOM, SHE BECAM ENGAGED IN SHORT CONVERSATION WITH A CLEANING WOMAN WHOM SHE DESCRIBED CUEAN, SHORT AND FAT, APPROXIMATELY 40-45 YEARS OF AGE, SHORT BROWN/RED HAIR, DRESSED IN WHITE UNIFORM.
