The caller said only that the Cambridge News reporter should call the American Embassy in London for some big news and then hung up. 3. After the word of the President's death was received the re-, porter informed the Cambridge police of the anonymous call and the police informed MI-5. The important point is that the call was made, according to MI-5 calculations, about 25 minutes before the President was shot. The Cambridge reporter had never received a call of this kind before and MI-5 state that he is known to them as a sound and loyal person with no security record. 4. MI-5 noted that similar anonymous phone calls of a strangely coincidental nature have been received by persons in the U. K. over the past year, particularly in connection with the case of Dr. Ward. 5.
