Reference San Diego airtel with enclosed LHM of same date sets out information from Agent RAMON OROZCO A, State Judicial Police, Mexicali, Baja California, Mexico. Reference Legat, Mexico, letter advised that the only American arrested by Mexican authorities during the course of President KENNEDY's visit to Mexico, 6/29 - 7/1/62, was DAVID JOSEPH ST. JACQUES aka. This letter also advised that the Mexico City Office investigation in instant matter is continuing.

Dallas has not received any further communication in this matter. It is requested that Legat, Mexico, be contacted to advise Dallas, in appropriate insert for report, of basis for and results of its investigation.
