Referenced Bureau cable stated GEORGE DE MOHRENSCHILDT had claimed he had been in British Intelligence during World War II (u)

On 3/24/64, Mr. [GEOFFREY HINTON], British Secret Intelligence Service, MI-6 advised there was no record in MI-6 for subject, GEORGE. He said that if subject had actually been in British Intelligence during World War II, the records of MI-6 should so reflect. Also on 3/24/64, Mr. RONALD SYMONDS, British Security Service, MI-5 was asked to recheck files. He advised that a recheck disclosed no additional information other than that reported in my referenced letter of March 6, 1964. (u)

There are enclosed eight copies of an LHM setting forth results of this inquiry. (u)

At the request of both MI-5 and MI-6, they are not being specifically mentioned in enclosure. (u)
