

- 6. Attached is being of possible interest is a photoprint of George De MOHRENSCHILDT's contracts with the Haitian Government which appeared in the Haiti Press. (Enclosure #7)
- The letters bearing the return address of High Plains Natural Gas Company, 1717 Southland Center, Dallas, Toxas, are from Samuel B. BALLIN, Chairman of the Board of High Plains Natural Gas Company. With respect to the letter bearing the return address of 3003 Hahanna Springs, Apartment B. Dallas, Toxas, our records reflect that it is the residence of Mrs. Ike CLARK, who has previously been reported by your Bureau as an aquaintance of the De MOHRENSCHILDTs. The letter from Madame De LEPOVATY (sic) in Paris, France, is undoubtedly from Vera de LIPOVATZ aka Vera SCHMIDT on whom you have furnished information in connection with the De MOHRENSCHILDTs. The letter from Dartmouth College signed by Dimitri (see enclosure #3) is from Dimitri De MOHRENSCHILDT, the brother of George. The author of the letters bearing the return address of Great Southwest Warehouses, Inc., Dallas, Texas, are probably from Pierre Rene FREYSS on whom we furnished information in our CSCI-316/0136-65 dated 5 April 1965, entitled "Activities in Haiti of George and Jeanne De MOHRENSCHILDT". The letters from KEARTON in Philadelphia. Pennsylvania, are from Christiana and Reginald KEARTON, the daughter and son-in-law respectively of George Do MOHREN-SCHILDT.
- 8. Your Bureau has previously furnished information on Lawrence ORLOV, George W. PRICE and George Mc MILLAN cited in paragraph 2 above.
- 9. The representative of this Agency in Paris, France, was unable to furnish any information on Tustyn STRUMITTO, cited in paragraph 2 above, who resides at 11 Rue Verniguet, Paris, France. If your Bureau so desires, this effice will query the appropriate French authorities for information on STRUMITTO.
- 10. No information is available in the files of this office on other persons mentioned in the above report.
