#### ADMINISTRATIVE

JOHN K. JACOBS was interviewed by SA JEROME E. VEIGLE. Results of that interview were furnished in letterhead memorandum dated 4/27/64, captioned "JOHN K. JACOBS, KATIA JACOBS." The letterhead memorandum was an enclosure to WFO airtel dated 4/27/64 under the OSWALD caption.

Dr. HERMINIO PORTELL-VILA was interviewed by SAs JAMES F. MORRISSEY and GENE L. BURGE on both occasions at WFO. The results of those interviews were furnished in letterhead memorandum enclosure to WFO airtel, both dated 5/15/64 under the OSWALD caption. Interview was requested by referenced Bureau telephone call 5/13/64.

WFO airtel 5/1/64 confirmed telephone call of WFO to Bureau of 4/30/64 re information obtained from WF 279-S\* on 4/30/64. The information revealed that ANATOLI F. DOBRYNIN, Soviet Ambassador to the United States, advised LLEWELLYN E. THOMPSON, Ambassador at Large, United States Department of State, regarding the business on the OSWALD case, He hoped that they (Russians?) would give the documents which they spoke of, on Monday or Tuesday, and would let THOMPSON know.

Another WFO airtel of 5/1/64 set forth the results of passport record checks of MARGARET A. WOLFF requested by referenced Bureau airtel to WFO 4/27/64. As pointed out in WFO airtel, any lead to locate and interview was left to the discretion of the Bureau or office of origin, since from information available, it was not known whether any of those revealed by the passport search were identical. On 5/18/64, Bureau telephonically advised not necessary to report above information on WOLFF since leads would handle reporting of same if pertinent.

El Paso airtel to Bureau 4/30/64 requested WFO to obtain from United States Secret Service file on ROBERT J. KAYE, a copy of a temporary visa issued to KAYE by Mexican Government and forward same to El Paso.
