Reference is made to our letter in this case dated July 28, 1964, dealing with Oswald's possession of the name Lev or Leo Setyaev, an announcer at Radio Moscow, and his reference in personal papers to having participated in a taped interview broadcast by Radio Moscow, probably in late 1959. *Reference is also made to British Security Service, III-5 Report Number 27, (S) captioned "Personalities in Radio Moscow Known to Viaduct," a copy of which is believed to be in your possession. *Further reference to Lev Setyaev and his current wife, Annette (Anita) Setyaeva, nee Zugoff, is contained in your letter in this case dated February 20 1964, your reference, CSCI-3/779,988. The individuals depicted therein from left to right are reportedly identifiable as follows: (1) Nikolai Sergeyev; (2) Annette (Anita) Setyaeva, nee Zugoff, formerly known as Annette Goldshteyn (Goldsstein) and (S)(u)

(7) Photograph of wedding party, depicting (1) at far left, head of Annette Setyaeva; (2) her son Kostia Henkin; (3) unknown female; (4) Annette Setyaeva's daughter, Marina, maiden name unknown, but probably Goldshteyn (Goldstein); (5) Vashi (Last Name Unknown), husband of Marina; and (6) four unknown individuals, two males and two females. Of the various individuals depicted in the enclosed photographs, Joseph Adamov is believed identical to the person of same name who is referred to in paragraph two of British Security Service Report Number 27 referred to above; and Annabelle Bucar is believed identical to the person referred to in paragraph six of the report. Sergei Rudin is likely identical with the Rudiman referred to in paragraphs eleven and 17 of the British report. (S)

Annette Setyaeva is believed to be identical with the Annette Goldstein (Khenkina) referred to in paragraph 14 of the report. This person was born October 18, 1919, at Lake Stevens, Washington, to William K. Zugoff, a Russian national, and Lillie May Edwards who was born at Northland, Michigan, in 1902. Setyaeva's mother, presently known as Lillie May Rahm, resides at Ketchikan, Alaska. (S)(u)

We would also appreciate any biographical data including descriptive material that Viaduct may be able to furnish concerning Lev or Leo Setyaev and we would like to have Viaduct's views as to how Setyaev's name came to be in the possession of Lee Harvey Oswald. Finally, we would like to know if Viaduct can furnish any information concerning the possible participation by Oswald in a taped interview broadcast by Radio Moscow in late 1959. (S) (u)

NOTE:

Classified "Secret" [as MI-5 and CIA have so classified previous communications concerning the matter at hand. Viaduct, a low-level KGB agent who defected to the British in 9/63, is (S) presently in the U. S. under CIA control. His bonafides have not been established and he is suspected to be a plant. CIA, according to Papich, plans to extensively interview him in an effort to reach a conclusion as to his bonafides. He was a writer and was associated with Radio Moscow in the late 1950s and MI-5 Report Number 27 (S) sets forth considerable information concerning individuals associated with Radio Moscow, some of whom he suspects to be in the service of the KGB. From personal papers of Oswald, it is believed he engaged in a broadcast over Radio Moscow in late 1959. He admitted this to his wife who cannot furnish further details. Viaduct may be able to fill us in in this regard. (S) (u)
