Synopsis:

FPCC National Office located at Rm. 329, 799 Broadway, NYC. VINCENT THEODORE LEE, FPCC National Office Director and only functioning officer of FPCC, intends to resign by 12/1/63. ALBERT S. BAKER of NYC, who appears to sympathize with the CP, reportedly to replace LEE as chief officer of FPCC. On 4/17/63, LEE stated that FPCC had about 1500 members. During October. 1963, LEE described FPCC financial situation as very poor and informant advised that FPCC bank balance as of 10/24/63, was \$173.52. LEE stated FPCC exists to get the absolute truth of the great Cuban revolution to the American people and that the FPCC supports the renewal of diplomatic relations with Cuba and has called upon the administration to rescird the US ban on travel to Cuba. In September, 1963, LEE described FPCC as largest distributor of Cuban propaganda in the US, if not the world, excluding the Cuban Government. On 6/24/63, LEE received 3 packages from the Cuban Mission to the UN. In May, 1963, informant advised that FPCC leadership had minimized the role of the CP and SWP during the past year and that the influence of outside organizations was then negligible. On 10/22/63, LEE advised that arrangements for the CP to take over FPCC had not materialized.
