SYNOPSIS: On 5/25/76, the NSC advised that the SSC Staff had been allowed to review documents in the LBJ Library relating to the Kennedy assassination and alleged assassination attempts against Fidel Castro. The SSC Staff has now requested copies of these documents and the NSC requested the views of the FBI by close of business, 5/26/76 as to whether the enclosed documents, which were classified by or concerned the FBI may be made available for delivery to or access by the SSC. The documents were reviewed by Intelligence Division and were approved with some deletions for delivery to SSC. One documents relating to extremely sensitive live informants (SOLO and FEDORA) will be approved for access only. Also approved for access only is a document reporting information furnished by J. Edgar Hoover on 11/24/63 to the White House with reference to Oswald. This document reports that Mr. Hoover advised that Oswald wrote a letter to the Soviet Embassy, Washington, D. Memorandum Kolombatovic to Leavitt Re: Senate Select Committee (SSC) Request for Lyndon Baines Johnson Library Documents

#### DETAILS CONTINUED:

A document captioned "Reaction of Soviet and Communist Party Officials to the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy," dated 1/1/66 contains information from highly sensitive live sources SOLO and FEDORA and it was decided that the "Top Secret" classification should continue and this document not be released for delivery to SSC; however, SSC Staff could be allowed to review the document at the NSC. Another document dated 11/24/63, dictated by "WJ" reports information furnished by Mr. J. Edgar Hoover. Mr. Hoover furnished information with reference to the Oswald murder and, among other things, advised that Oswald had made a telephone call to the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City which "we"FBl intercepted and that Oswald also wrote a letten to the Soviet Embassy, Washington, D. C. which Twe"FB intercepted, read and resealed. This document at the present time is not classified and it was the conclusion of the Intelligence Division that the document should be classified "Secret" and should not be made available for delivery to the SSC. However, it could be made available for review by the SSC at the NSC. The document was prepared at the White House and "WJ" is believed to be Walter Jenkins.
