Inclosed for legst are title page and 40 pages of your 5/18 last summary letterhead in this case which have been amonded by the Bureau in order to enable declassification of your summary letterhead. The declassified version of your summary letterhead has been reproduced by the Bureau on meres equipment and, where possible, the pages in your original summary were utilized in the unclassified version. The 40 pages enclosed herewith, when inserted among the appropriate pages in your classified letterhead, constitute the unclassified version furnished to the Brusident's Commission. Note in this regard that the information set forth on pages 122 through and including 127 of your classified letterhead has been condensed into pages 122 through and including 124 in the unclassified version. This has necessitated remakering the pages in the original draft beginning with page 135. The unclassified version is now 178 pages in length as eppthed to the 181-page classified version.

Hote that on page 304 of the Counterion's summary report the Counterion states in part as follows, "...the Government of Mexico initiated a thorough investigation to unequer as such information as possible on Gerald's trip. Representatives of U.S. agencies worked in close limison with the Mexican law enforcement authorities." introductory statement coincides with aforementioned statement of the Commission and is designed to emphasize the lisison capacity of V. S. representatives in Monico. You vill note that the Bureau did not delete all references to the T symbol sources in the unclassified version for in Dureen's opinion to do so and to morely report results of investigation in a Bureau letterhead vithout reference to various sources would erente the impression that Bureau representatives, in fact, conducted the reported investigation. Note, however, that all references in your classified version to the first confidential source abroad have either been deleted or attributed to T-17, who is identified in your 3/18 letter transmitting the summary. In addition, all references to T symbol sources, who obviously were members of the Imbassy staff, have been deleted. The latter area includes reporting of results of interviews of people who called at the Embersy to volunteer information. (X/W

In preparing the uncleasified version, the Bureau has endeavored to include therein results of all investigation, specifically remested by the Cosmission and any investigation which was touched upon in the Comissions sweary report. Accordingly, it was not possible to completely delete all of the information concerning Charles Fall. The information concerning Small furnished by Link Telephone Deep been further condensed in the unclassified version and taken when information was furnished by sources have been deleted.

In view of the entensive investigation conducted into the allegations of <u>Gutierres</u> Valencia and in light of the temous nature of his claims, bufeau decard it insovisable to delete his identity.
