[Mex-18 and Mex-19] information that the Silver and gift shop of Charles Small does not sell post cards and bracelets imported from Japan and therefore subject could not have purchased such items there. Informants also checked the 4 known outlets for imported Japanese goods and found no bracelets on sale similar to the one purchased by Oswald. Information set forth in [134-10A-1163] ~~(u)~~ and reported to Bureau in letterhead memorandum 3/23/64 (MCfile 105-3702-495) ~~(u)~~
