ReBuairtel to Albany dated 4/15/64, Bucab dated 4/24/64 and my cab dated 4/27/64.

Agents assigned to this office have advised that immediately following the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, all informants and sources of this office were alerted to the requirement that all information which they might receive having any bearing on the assassination or suspect LEE HARVEY OSWALD should be reported without delay. Security and investigative informants have been contacted regularly since 11/22/63, and have been reminded of the necessity of being alert for and reporting all information coming to their attention with respect to these inquiries.

As the Bureau is aware, information received from informants MEX-18 and MEX-19 as to reactions and comments within the American Communist Group in Mexico concerning the assassination and OSWALD has been forwarded to the Bureau by cable, airtel and letterhead memorandum.

With respect to informants [MEX-48] and [MEX-61] it will be noted that they were contacted on 4/11/64.
