Malin says thatalmost all of USDS personnel are some place or another greeting the incoming officicals of foreign nations, that it would be virtually impossible to do anything today, but that first thing tomorrow he will bring it to the attention of those who handle press matters, fortheir consideration. WKYENEWKXZSSSX OK, yhanks much.
