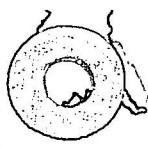
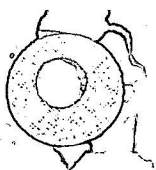

November 27, 1963

On November 26, 1963, Agent HANCO GROSSO A., of the State Judicial Police, Mexicali, Baja California, Mexico, advised he had learned unofficially through his office that during the late President KENNEDY's visit to Mexico in 1962, (Secret Police) of Mexico City arrested an American whom they had received information was planning an assassination of KENNEDY in Mexico.

GROSSO said he did not learn the name of the alleged American, but expressed a belief this information would be made available by the Mexican Secret Police, Mexico City, if it is not already in the possession of the United States authorities.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.
