VINCENT MARCELLO ANTI-RACKETEERING NEW ORLEANS FILE 92-657

On 5/10/67, PETER IMBORNONE, a former JPSO Deputy who resigned after his arrest relative to an extortion matter investigated by the JPSO and LSP during the summer of 1966, opened a new night spot, "The Club Pisano," on Airline Hwy., Metairie, La. It was noted that VINCENT MARCELLO was at the night spot during a considerable period of time during the evening and, from the activity and attention shown to MARCELLO by IMBORNONE, it appeared as if MARCELLO had some type of control of this new club.

Information has been previously received from informants and JPSO Vice Squad Officers that IMBORNONE has, in the recent past, become closely aligned with the MARCELLO brothers.

CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE PROGRÂM NEW ORLEANS DIVISION NEW ORLEANS FILE 92-50

NO 1496-C

On 4/26/67, NO 1496-C advised that recent arrests have been made at various Bossier City night clubs on 4/17/67, relative to gambling activity. As a result of these arrests, a meeting was held by Chief of Police CATHEY, Bossier City, with commanding officers of the Bossier City PD and the result of this meeting was that the charges against the individuals arrested were dismissed. Informant reported that Major GEORGE NATTIN allegedly advised the arrested parties that open gambling would be permitted on the Strip, which would include all forms of gambling except slot machines. The Major reportedly advised that gambling would be allowed so long as he received his cut. Informant further stated that his information was that only Major NATTIN, Capt. SAM TEUTCH and the brother of Major NATTIN, WAYLEN, would receive a cut from the gambling activity.

NO 1416-C advised that Attorney MICHAEL MAROUN, Shreveport, La., who is CARLOS MARCELLO's lawyer in that vicinity, advised him that he would be handling the "deal" to finance the opening of the Sawyer Downs Race Track in Bossier City, La. Informant was of the opinion that if this were the case there would be "Syndicate" money involved at the track and in all probability the majority of this money would be the MARCELLOS'.

DIXIELAND PARK, INC.

ANDREW L. ERWIN, interim president of Dixieland Park, Inc., announced that plans were being formulated to begin immediate construction of a six million dollar race track on a 235 acre track of land in St. Tammany Parish, La., as a result of the successful raising of two million dollars by the Dixieland Park Corporation.

ERWIN stated that the Louisiana Racing Commission has given assurances to the Corporation of their opening racing dates for the new track, which has a target date for completion set for 4/1/68. According to ERWIN, it is expected that this track will run 50 days prior to and 50 days after the completion of the New Orleans Fair Grounds' racing season.
