On 12/6/63 ALFRED GERTHOFFERT of the Police Judiciaire (criminal police), Surete Nationale, advised that <u>SUZANNE FRUEGER</u> mentioned in recab arrived at Orly Airport at 8:25 A.M. 12/6/63 and departed 9:05 A.M. the same day en route Munich. He said that she remained "in transit" and therefore there is no official record of her having entered France on that date.
