The Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy, furnished the following information on January 24, 1964:

Gus Alex, a United States citizen in possession of U. S. passport D074551, and his paramour, Dietgard Fueger, a German citizen born Seewalchen, December 3, 1938, in possession of German passport 4019969 issued by the German Consulate in Chicago, Illinois, on October 16, 1961, arrived in Milan, Italy, on Jahuary 6, 1964. They registered at the Hotel Principe e Savoia and remained there until January 7, 1964, when they left Milan for an unknown destination. Their method of travel is not known.

During the time Alex and Fueger were in Milan they were not observed contacting other individuals, nor did they come to police attention.
