On 2/21/73, the Surete Generale (SG), Beirut, Lebanon, advised that an extensive search of its Arrival-Departure records failed to indicate any information that subject had entered or departed Lebanon or was presently in Lebanon. It should be noted that stops placed by Interpol concerning subject remain in effect. (S)(X)u

On 2/26/73, JOSEPH ASCHOUH (protect identity), Superintendent, Country Club of Lebanon, (CCL) Beirut, advised that he contacted key personnel at the CCL and exhibited the photograph of the subject to them and asked if they recognized him. With the exception of one, all advised that he was not known to them. One individual advised that the photograph resembled an individual who played golf on two occasions in October or November, 1972, at the CCL as a guest of one of the members. He could not recall who the member was or if this was the same individual as in the photograph. He stated that if this individual ever returns he will observe him carefully and note who accompanies him. (X)u

It should be noted that the Casino Du Liban, the only gambling casino in Lebanon, is presently closed for repairs and alterations. It is scheduled to open in April, 1973. (X)u

Investigation in this matter is continuing (X)u

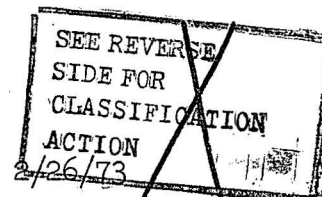
